

BYSTANDER INTERVENTION/TITLE IX

The Office of Equity Diversity and Inclusion partnered with FSL to rethink bystander intervention/Title IX education for members and piloted a new Prevention Dialogue series. The program was developed with the goal of increasing thoughtful, ongoing, prevention-based dialogue within all Fraternity and Sorority Life chapters at Pitt. Members participated in regular discussions on topics such as consent, healthy relationships, sexuality, bystander intervention and supporting survivors of sexual misconduct. Ongoing dialogue is an important part of building a safe and respectful campus.

HAZING PREVENTION

The Hazing Prevention Committee (a collaboration with other units across campus) hosted a variety of events for Hazing Prevention Week, including a viewing of the documentary "Breathe, Nolan, Breathe" followed by a panel discussion with campus and student leaders with 5% of the community in attendance.

FRATERNITY AND SORORITY LIFE 101

Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 is a one-hour introductory program for students who are interested in joining a fraternity or sorority. All new members and aspirants must attend before accepting a bid to join a chapter. The program goes over the basics of our community, how to join, what to expect, and how to make it a positive experience.

- 1,246 students attended this year
- 94% of attendees found Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 helpful.
- 99.5% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel more comfortable identifying hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.
- 99.4% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel empowered to speak out against hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.

Some highlights from this year's Greek Week:

- Steel City Step Show was back and better than ever at Soldiers & Sailors Auditorium, where 1,499 attendees from FSL, the greater campus and Pittsburgh community, and beyond got to see our NPHC groups' impressive step performances
- **Greek Sing** took place in person, collaborating with Pitt Program Council for an outdoors event on a bigger stage than previous years. The event drew over 2,000 dedicated attendees who stood in a mix of rain, sunshine, and sleet to watch each team's creative dance routines and themes
- **770 blood donations** from our community during Greek Week Blood Drives, benefitting over 2,300 hospital patients
- **2 successful donation drives:** 1,730 clothing items donated to Thriftsburgh and a successful food drive benefitting the Pitt Pantry
- **526 members** attended the community conversation on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion in FSL hosted by Dr. Paul Harper during Greek Week



The Cathedral Standards of Excellence Program will provide a framework for self-assessment, individual and group accountability, greater achievement of organizational goals, and the development of programs and practices that will lead to substantial enrichment of the fraternity and sorority experience. This program recognizes and rewards those organizations that consistently exceed expectations as well as provides guidance and support to those organizations that fail to meet the expectations of the University and the Fraternity and Sorority Life Community.

CHAPTERS ARE EVALUATED ON THE FOLLOWING STANDARDS:

- ★ ACADEMICS (A)
- MEMBER DEVELOPMENT (MD)
- ★ CHAPTER RESPONSIBILITY (CR)
- ★ POSITIVE RELATIONSHIPS (PR)
- ★ CIVIC ENGAGEMENT (CE)

Chapters will be given results on a **FIVE-STAR SCALE** to correspond with the five categories of the Cathedral Standards of Excellence. Chapters will be given a star for each category in which they complete the minimum requirements.
