Summary and Highlights of Placement Data

The Career Center assists University of Pittsburgh students and graduates in securing quality internships and employment. The Career Center conducts extensive research on each graduating class, and annually provides the University with comprehensive and uniform data on the post-graduation plans of its recent graduates.

Along with many other colleges and universities, the Career Center at the University of Pittsburgh has recently aligned our survey collection standards with those of the National Association of Colleges & Employers (NACE). The Career Center distributes the Post-Graduation Status Survey through the First Destination Survey module in Handshake, a comprehensive career services platform. Data was analyzed using Microsoft Excel and Tableau (data visualization software). The use of these applications included pivot tables and queries to retrieve the desired analysis. The surveyed participants include graduates of Fall and Summer 2018 and Spring 2019.

Total Knowledge Rate

The total number of distinct graduates (4,489) was taken from the University's PeopleSoft database, which reports bachelor's degrees granted to students. Students who graduated in the Spring of 2019, as well as those who graduated in the Summer or Fall of 2018 are included in this number and are considered the Survey Class of 2019. The total number of distinct graduates who completed the post-graduation survey or for whom information was submitted was **3,166**, a total knowledge rate of **71%**. The chart below displays response rate by college or school.

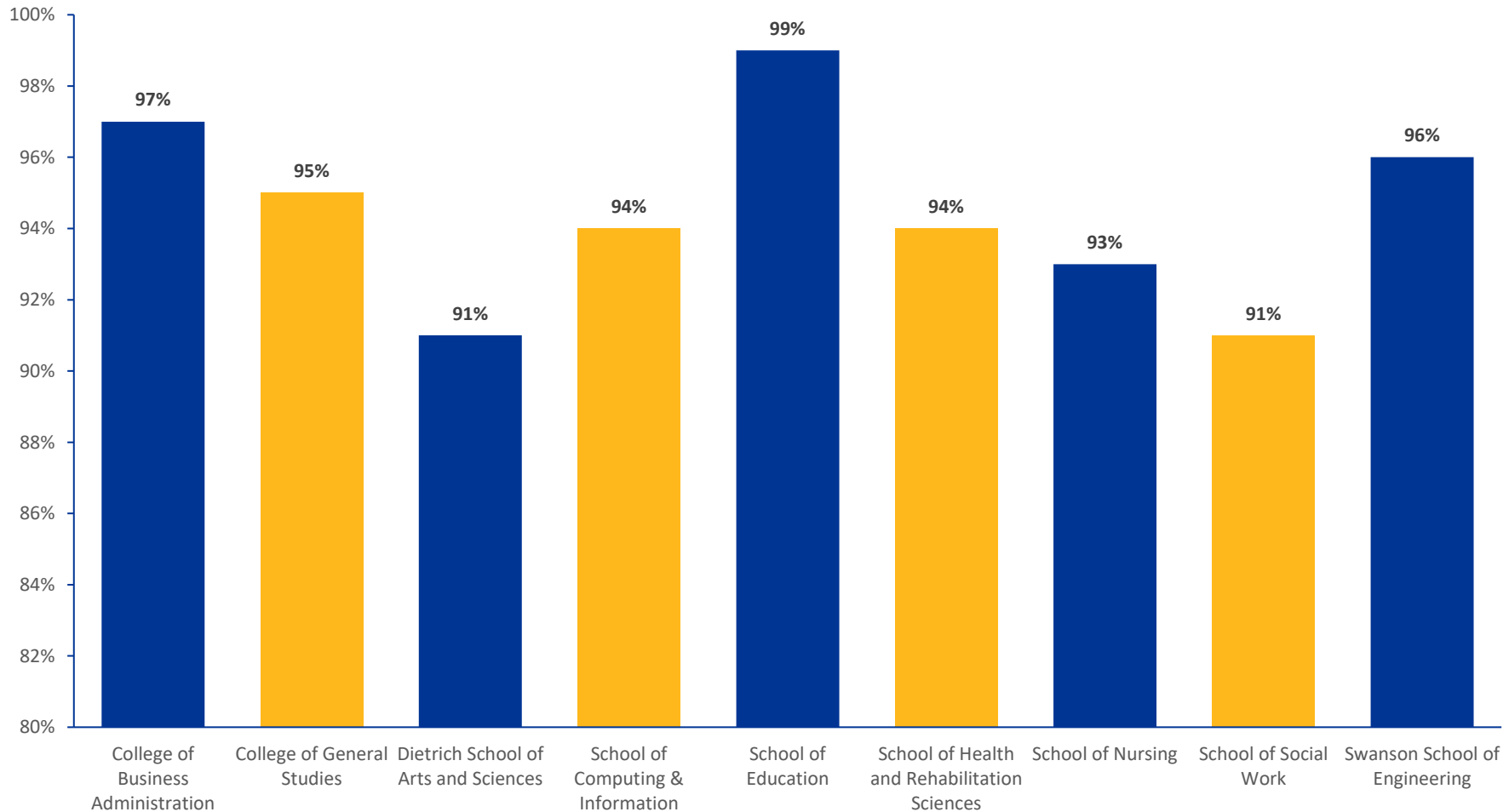

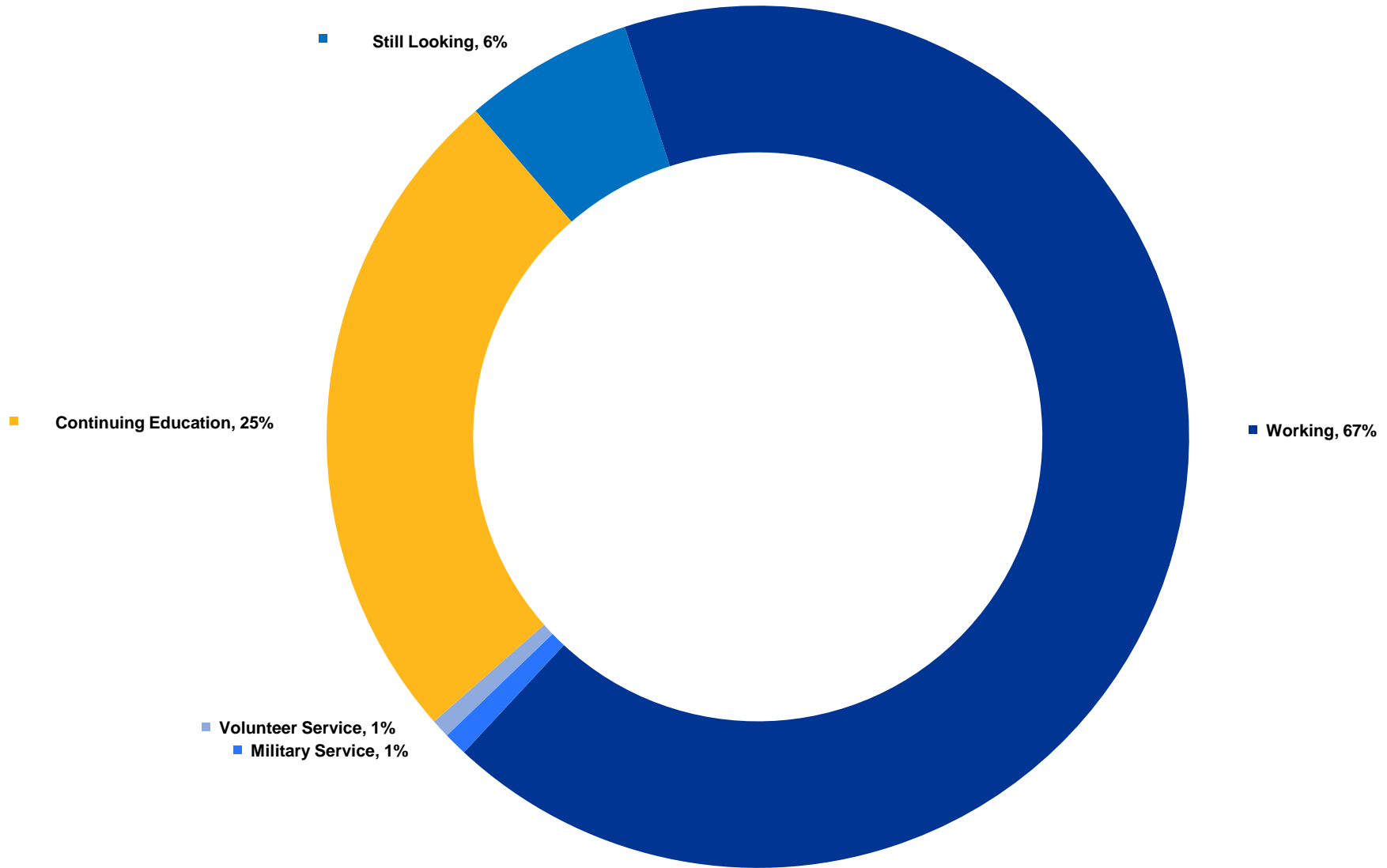

Placement Rate

The Career Center bases its placement rates on the total number of recent graduates who provided information on their status. The Career Center considers those working (67%, 2,109 of 3,151), starting their own business (0%, 0 of 3,151), continuing their education (25%, 792 of 3,151), volunteering in a service program (1%, 22 of 3,151), and serving in the military (1%, 28 of 3,151) as successfully placed after graduation. The total percentage of graduates successfully placed was 94% (2,951 of 3,151) for the Survey Class of 2019. The following data is a breakdown of placement rate by college or school.

Employment

Of the recent graduates responding to the survey, 64% (2,011 of 3,151) answered that they are employed full-time. Three percent (98 of 3,151) indicated that they are employed part-time.

One hundred percent (2,109 of 2,109) of all employed graduates reported the name of their employer. Salary information was reported by 40% (840 of 2,109) of those graduates working.

Continuing Education

Approximately 25% (792 of 3,151) of those graduates responding to the survey indicated that they are continuing their education.

Of those recent graduates that provided data on the type of degree they are pursuing, 92% (731 of 791) responded that they are enrolled in a graduate program. The remaining graduates (8%) are earning a certificate, advanced certificate, associates, bachelors, non-degree seeking, and postdoctoral studies. Military, Volunteer Service, or Other Plans

One percent (28 of 3,151) of University of Pittsburgh graduates reported that they are actively serving in the military. In addition, 1% (22 of 3,151) of graduates are committed to a volunteer program.

Still Seeking

Of the recent graduates responding to the survey, 6% (200 of 3,151) indicated that they are not employed but are seeking employment.

Summary

The total percentage of graduates successfully placed is 94%, which has been consistent for the past seven years. The total knowledge rate for the Survey Class of 2019 is **71%**, compared to a 78% response rate for the Survey Class of 2018. The decrease in percentage is attributed to the change in the data collection timeline of the First Destination Survey to align with NACE. Whereas the Class of 2018 survey officially closed in March 2019, this year's survey was closed on December 31, 2019, ensuring total compliance with NACE guidelines. The percentage of recent graduates still seeking employment six months after graduation is **6%** for the Survey Class of 2019.

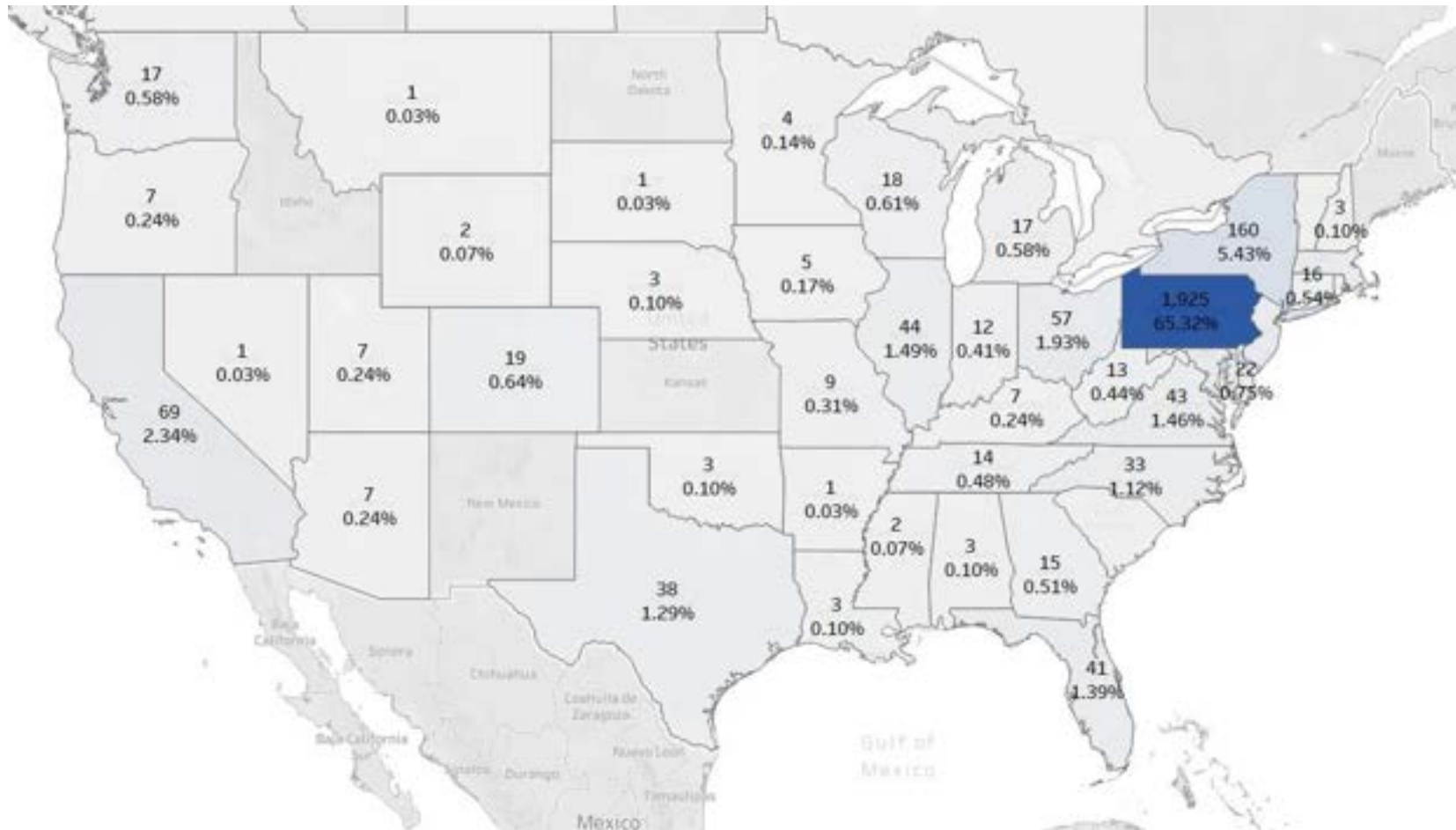

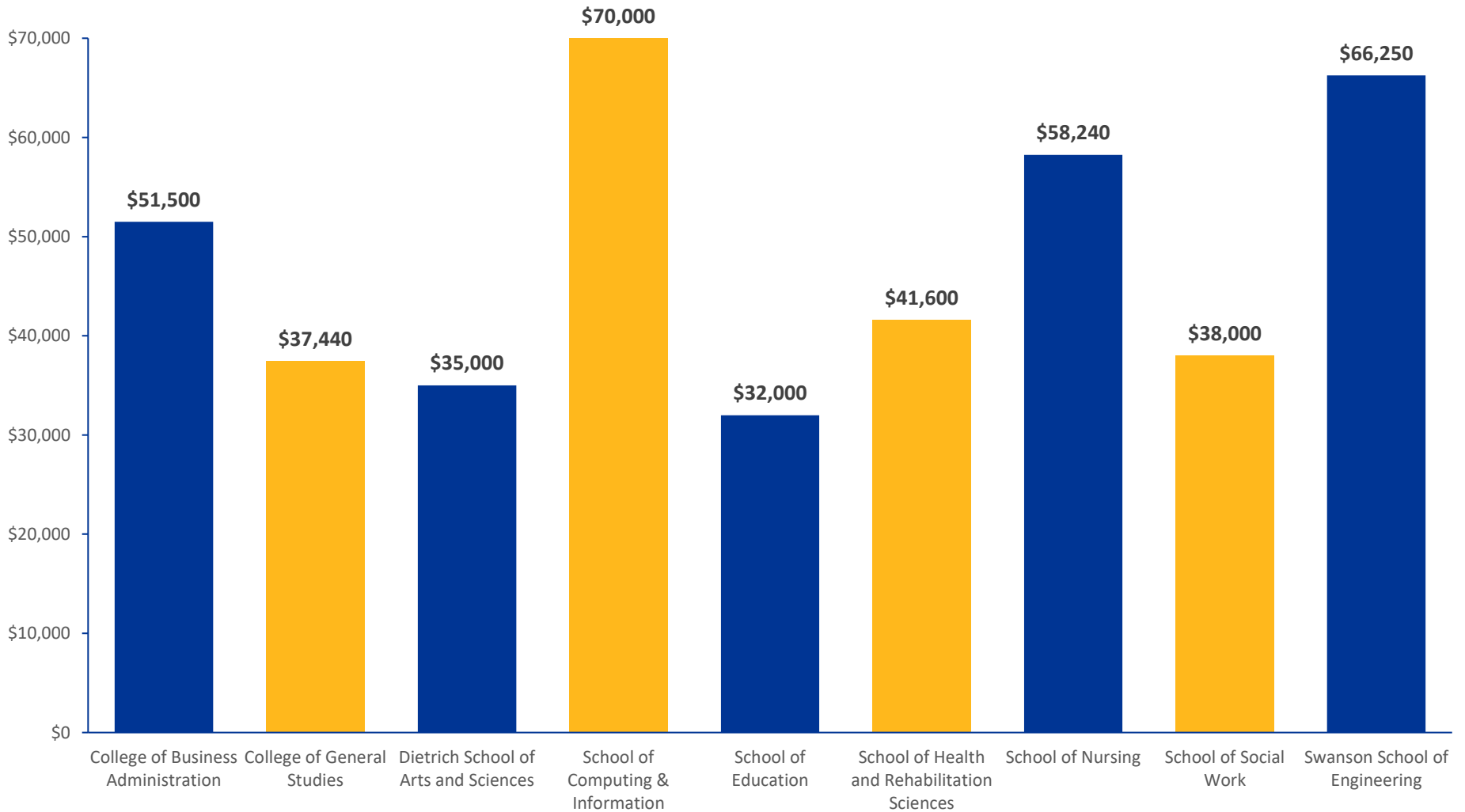

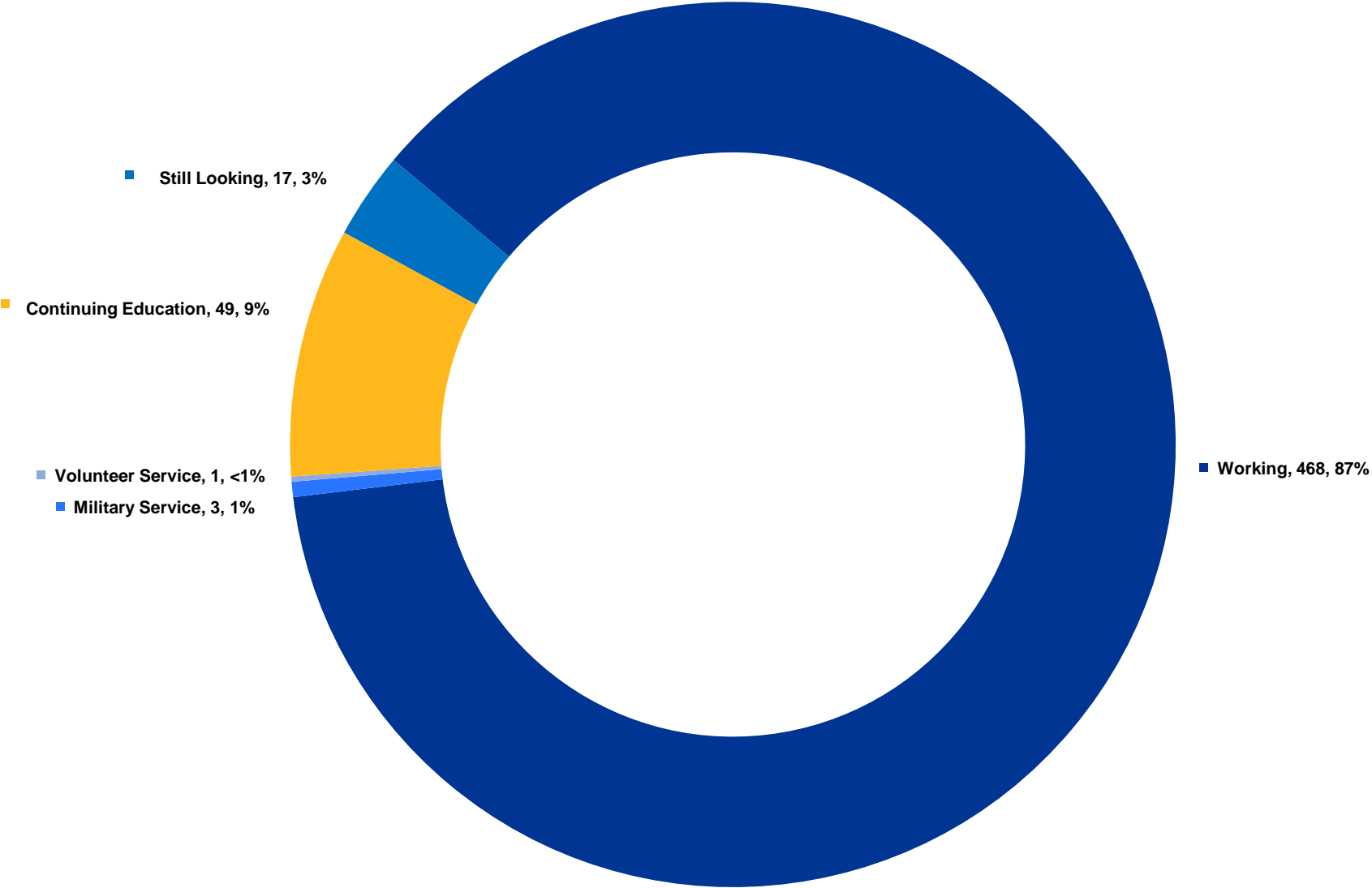

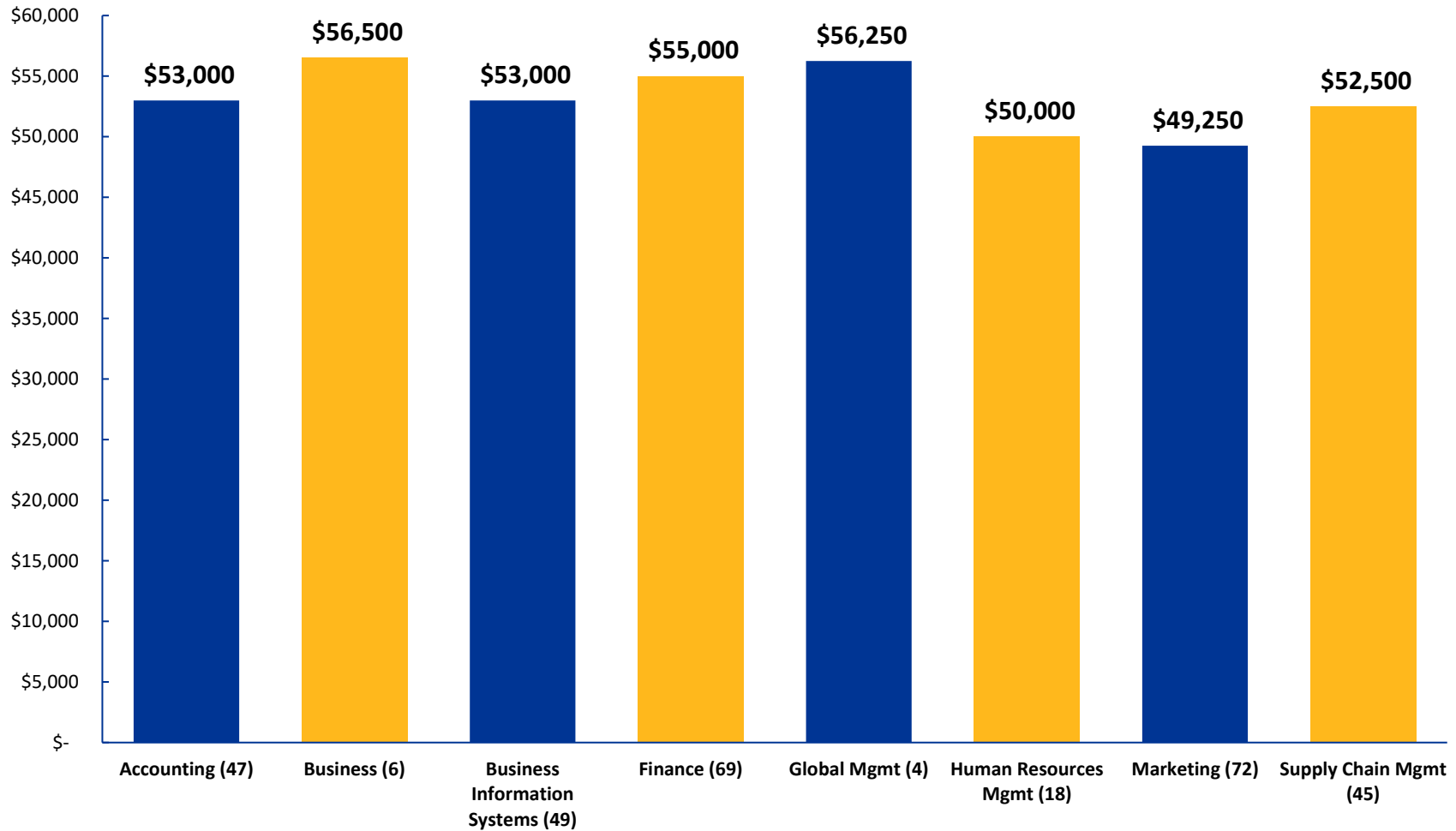

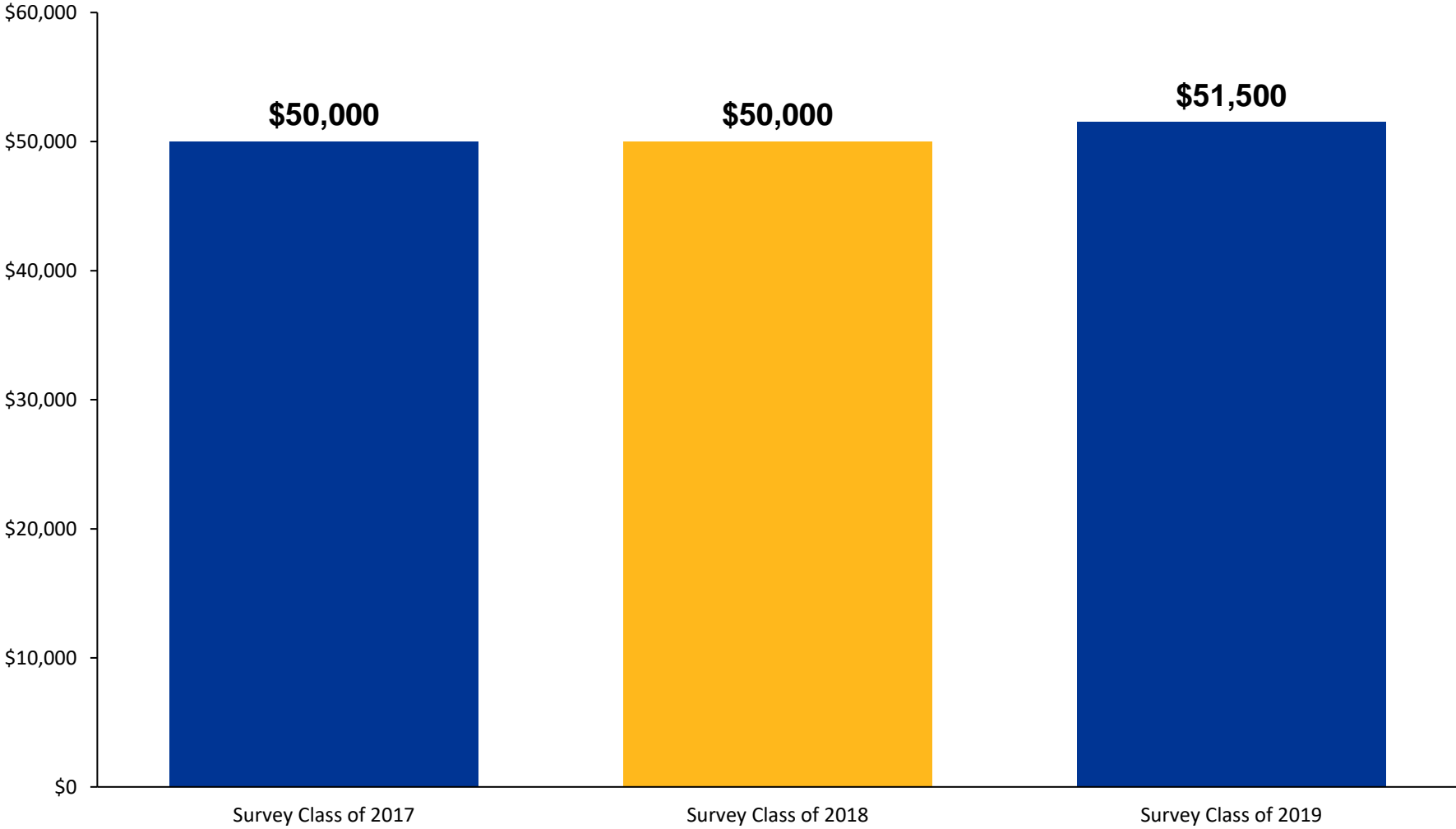

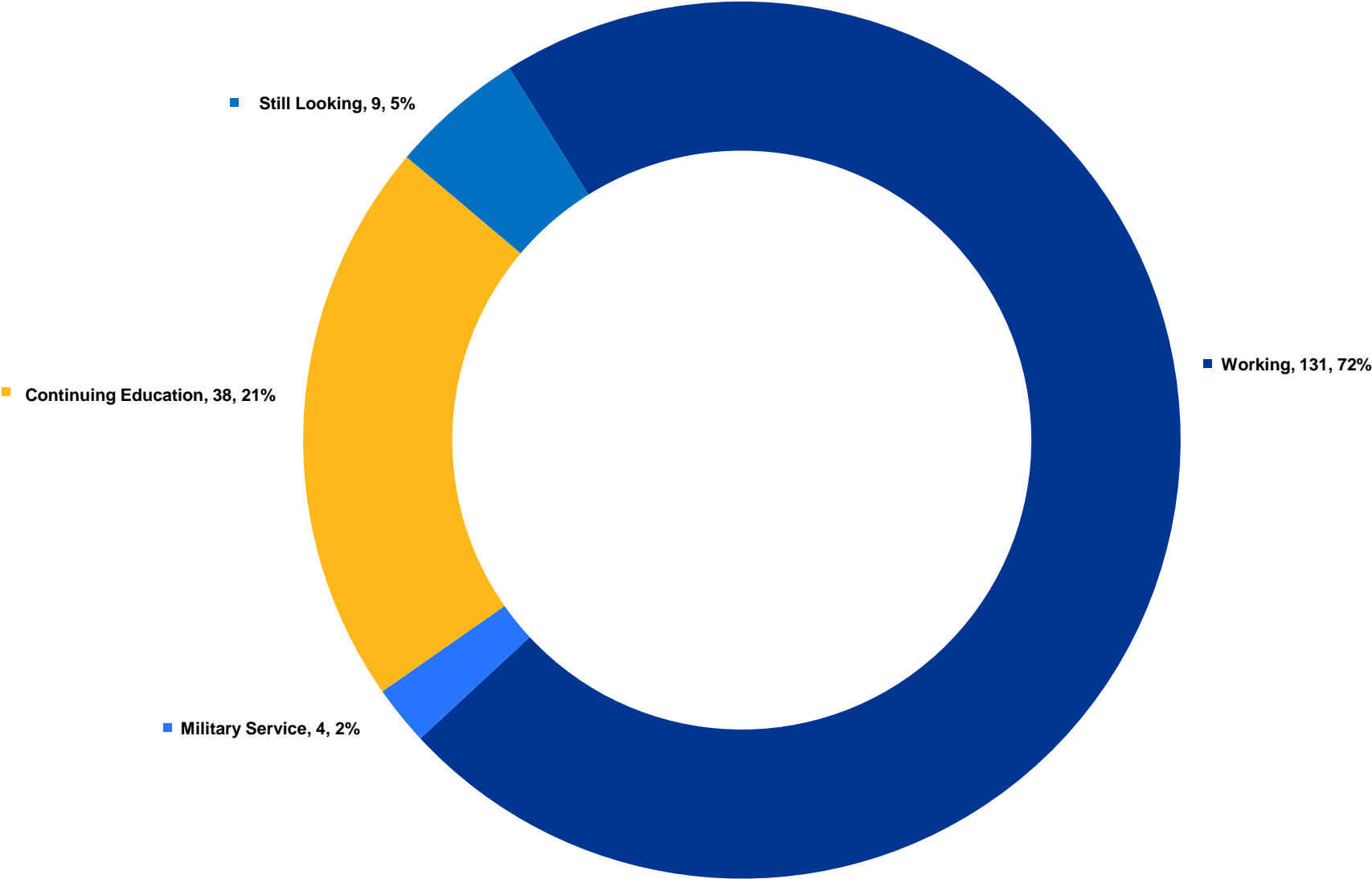

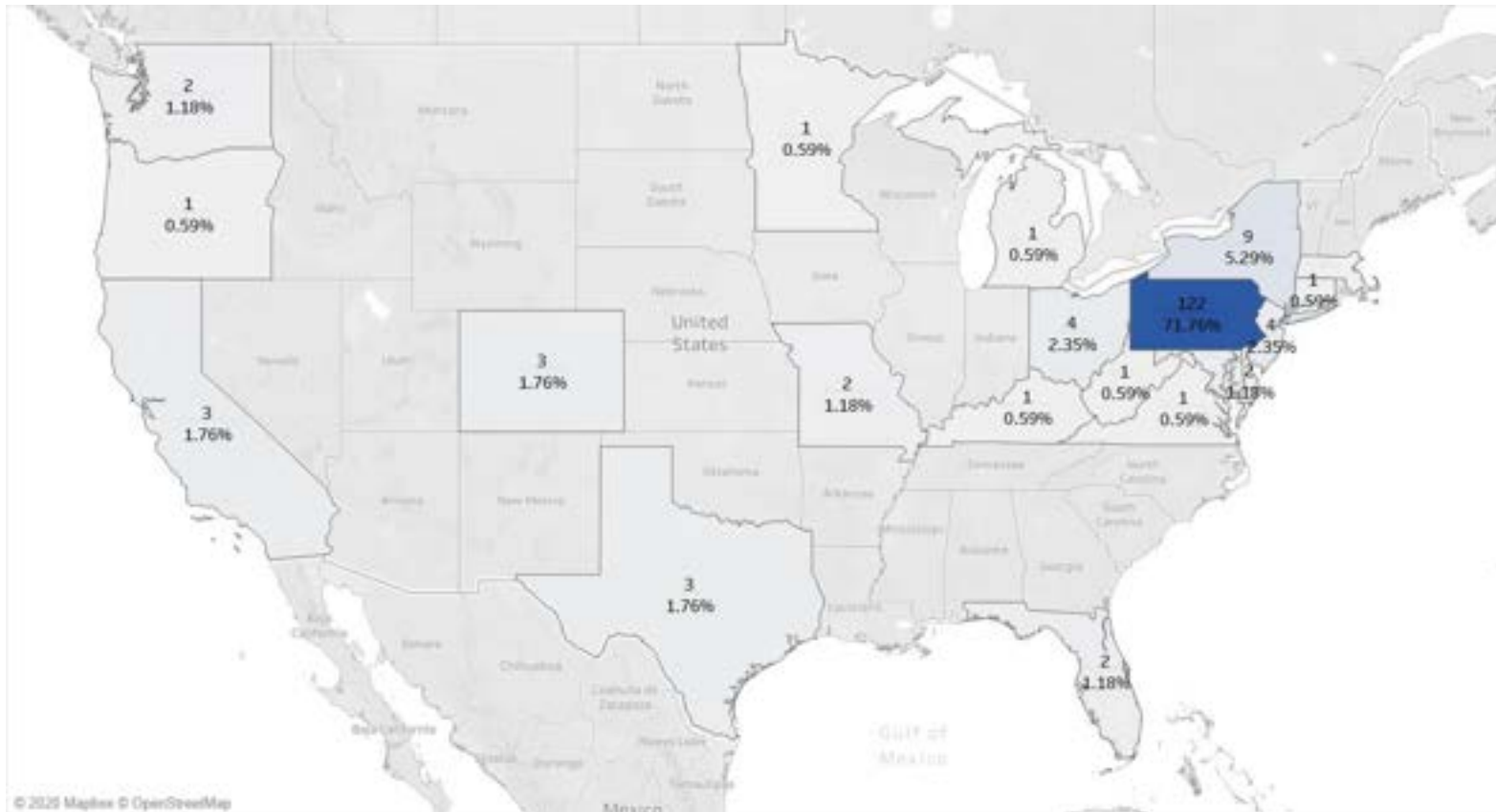

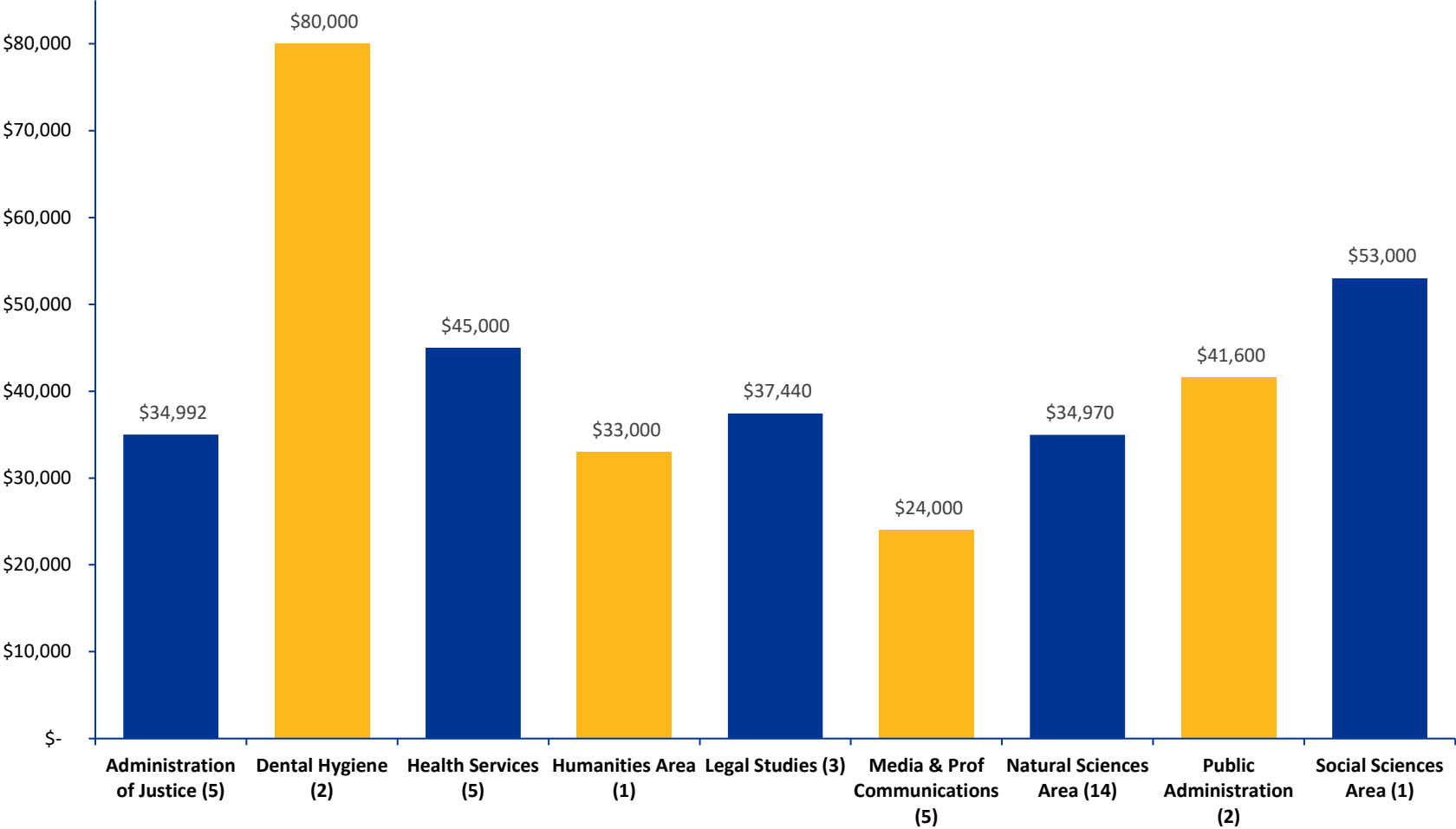

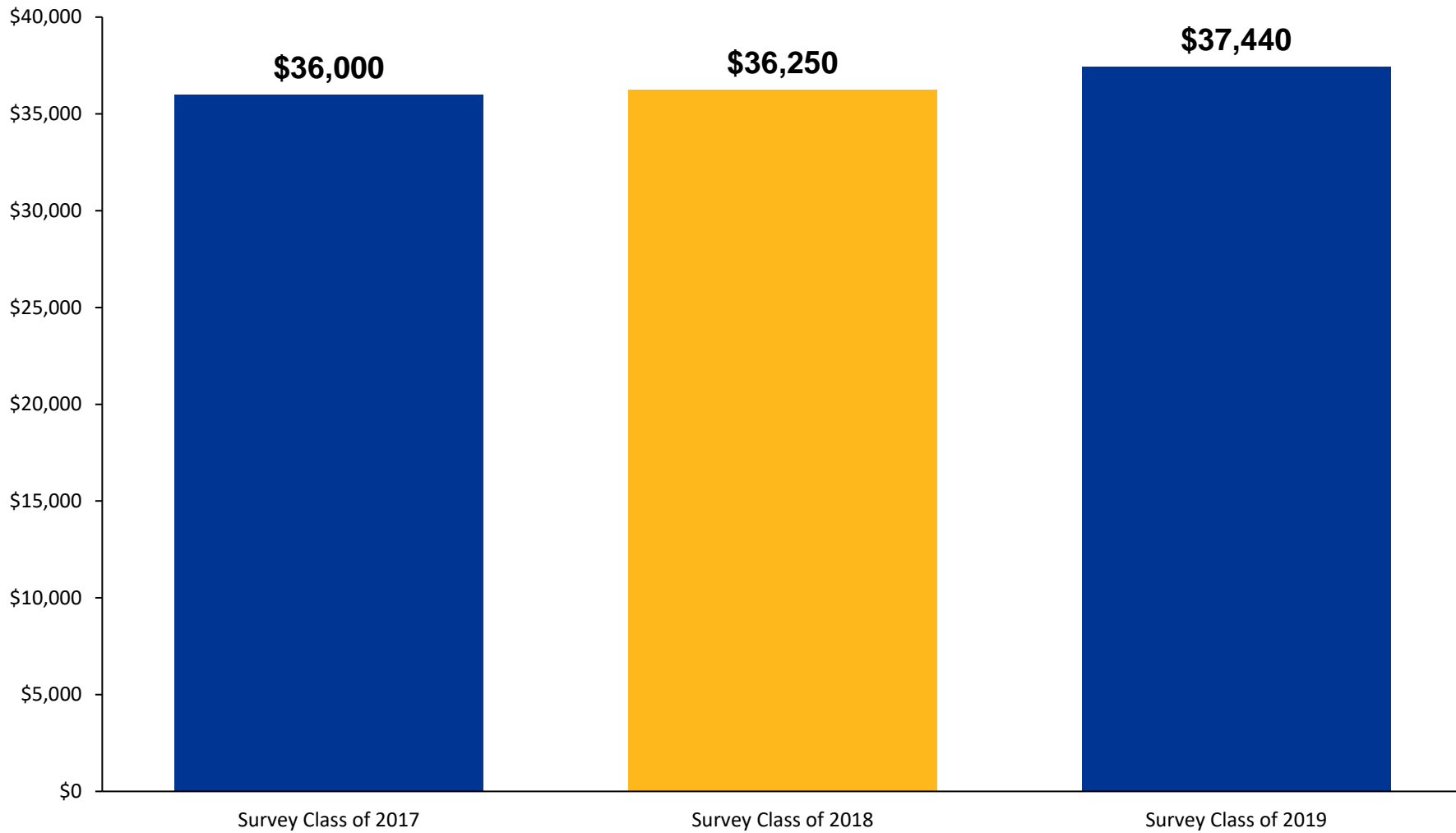

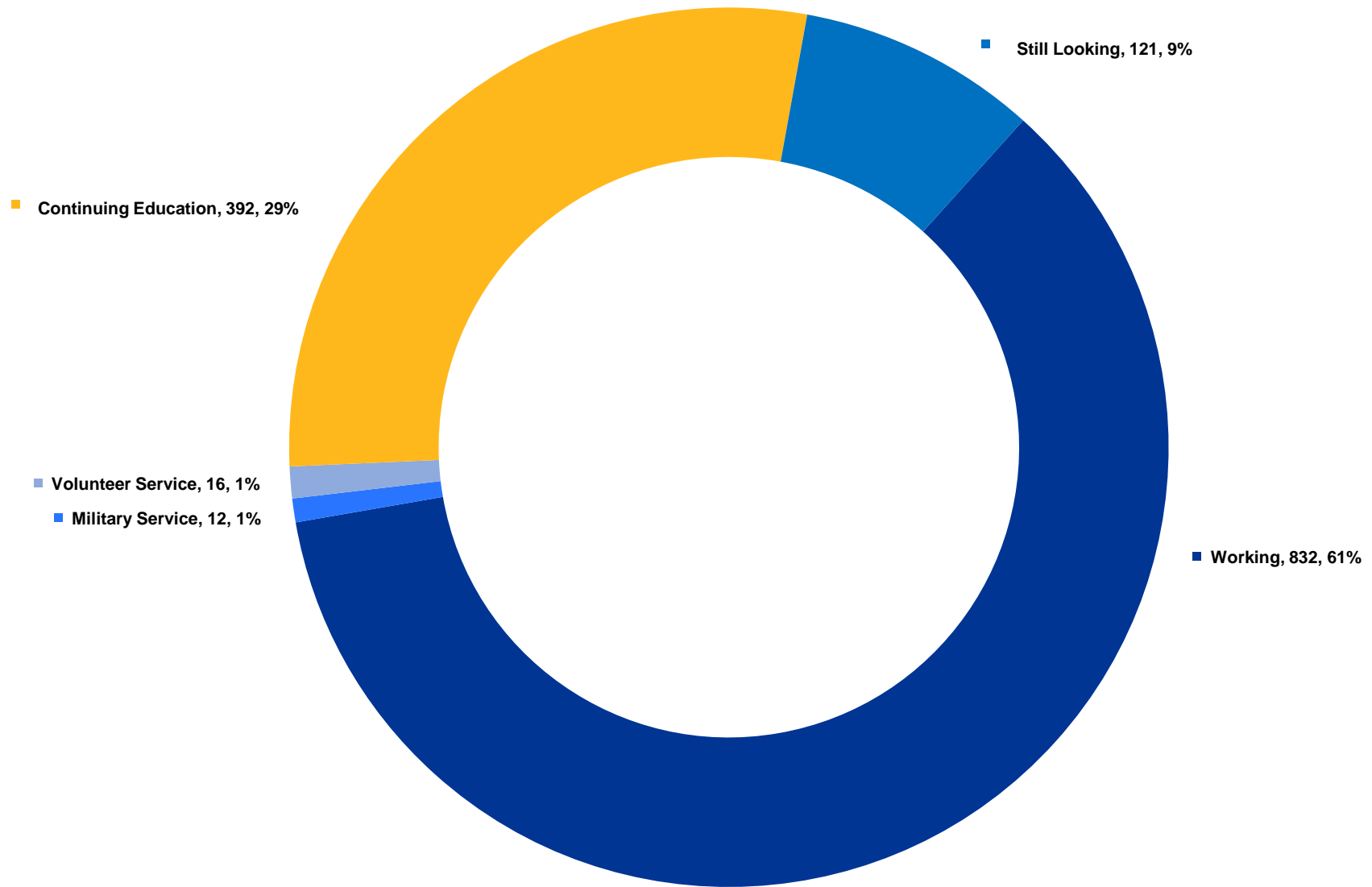

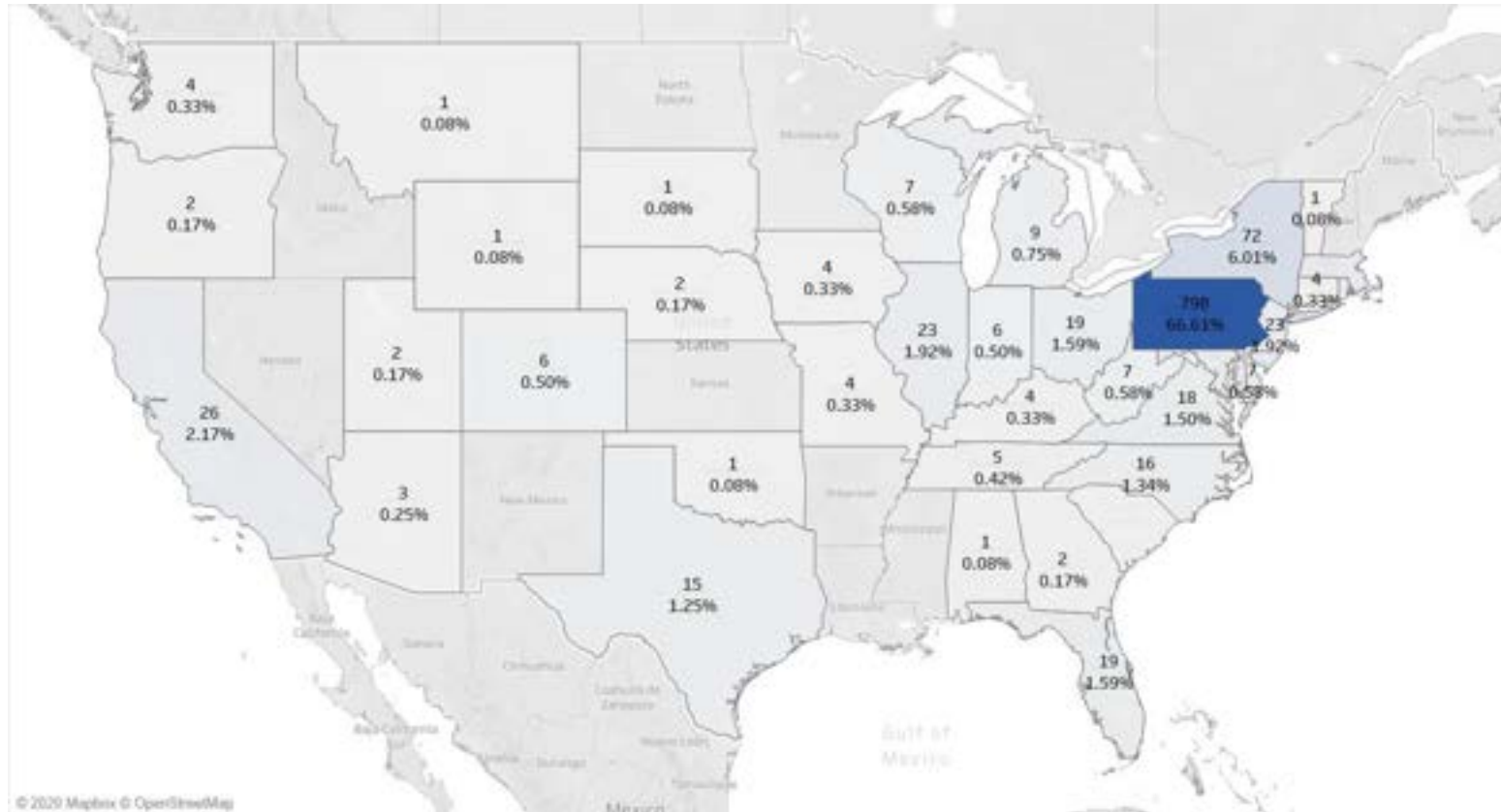

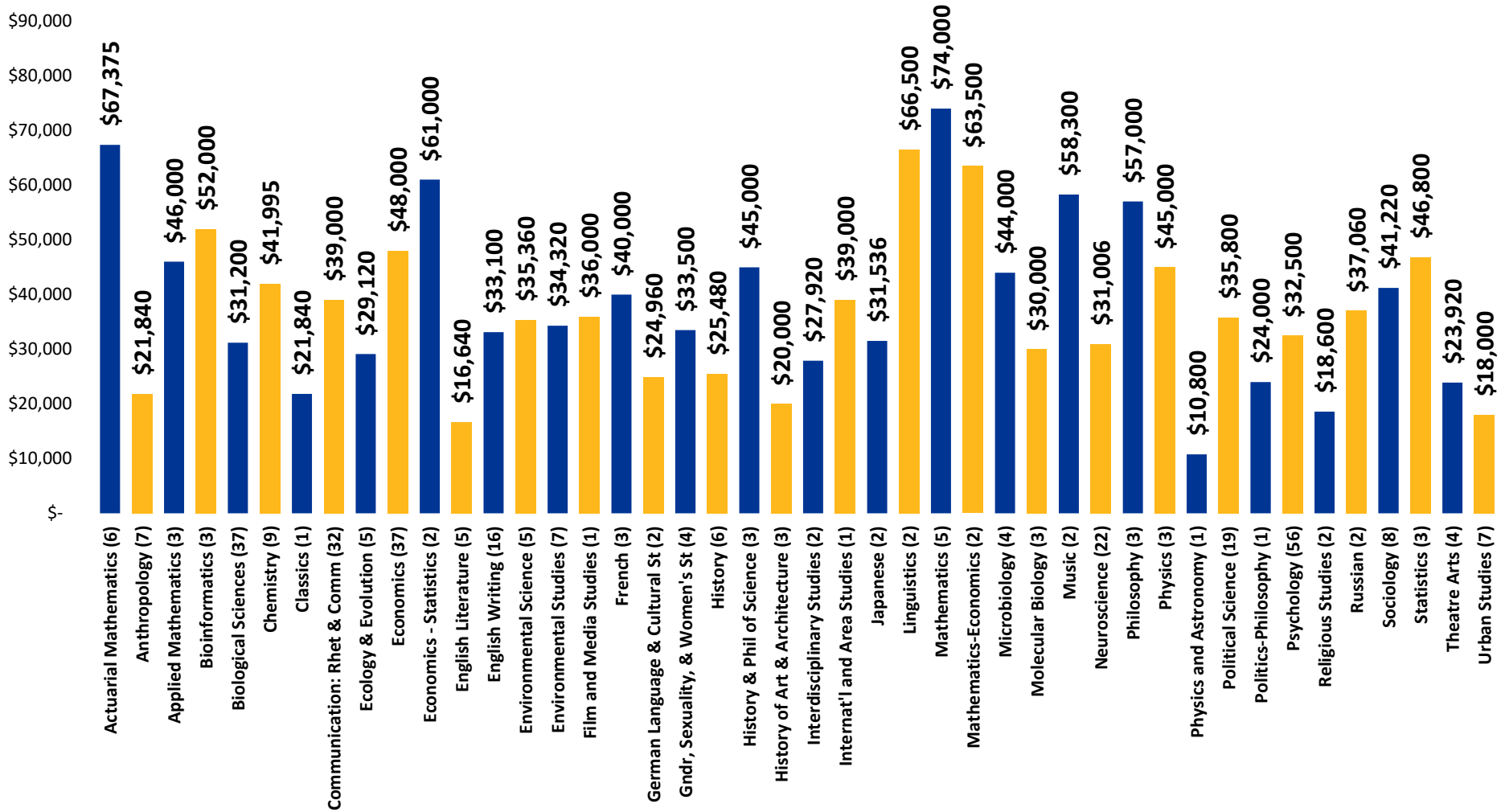

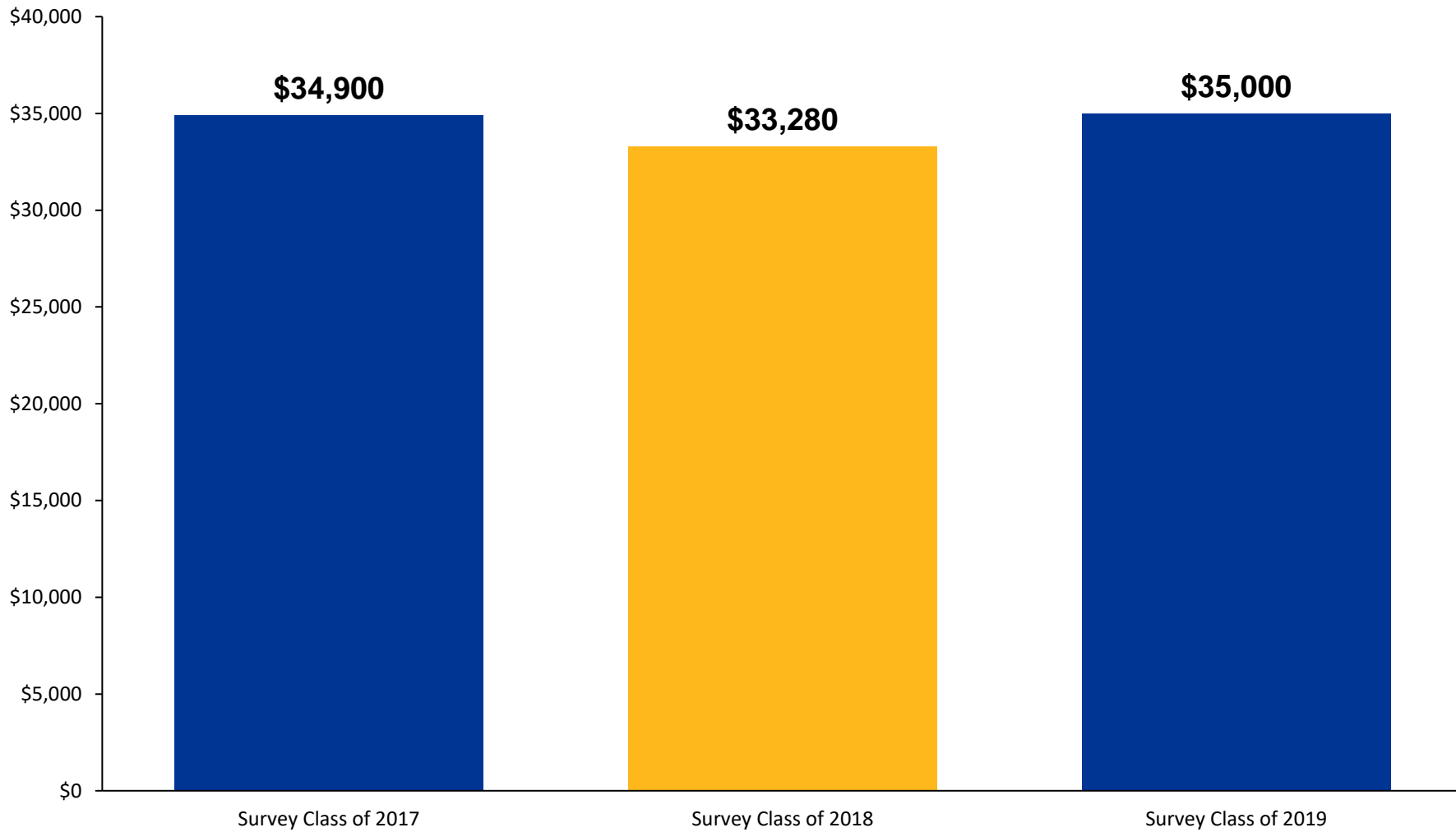

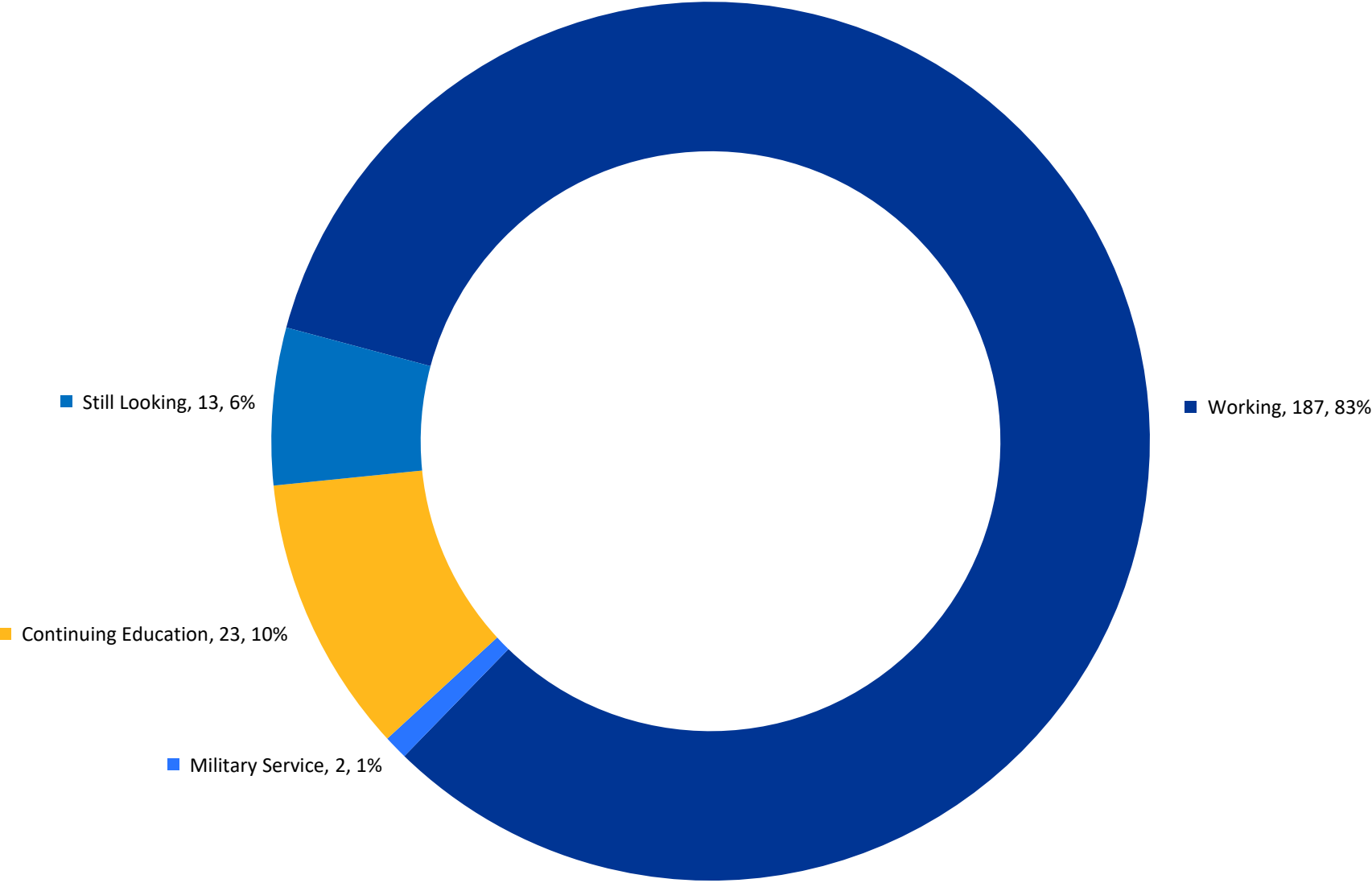

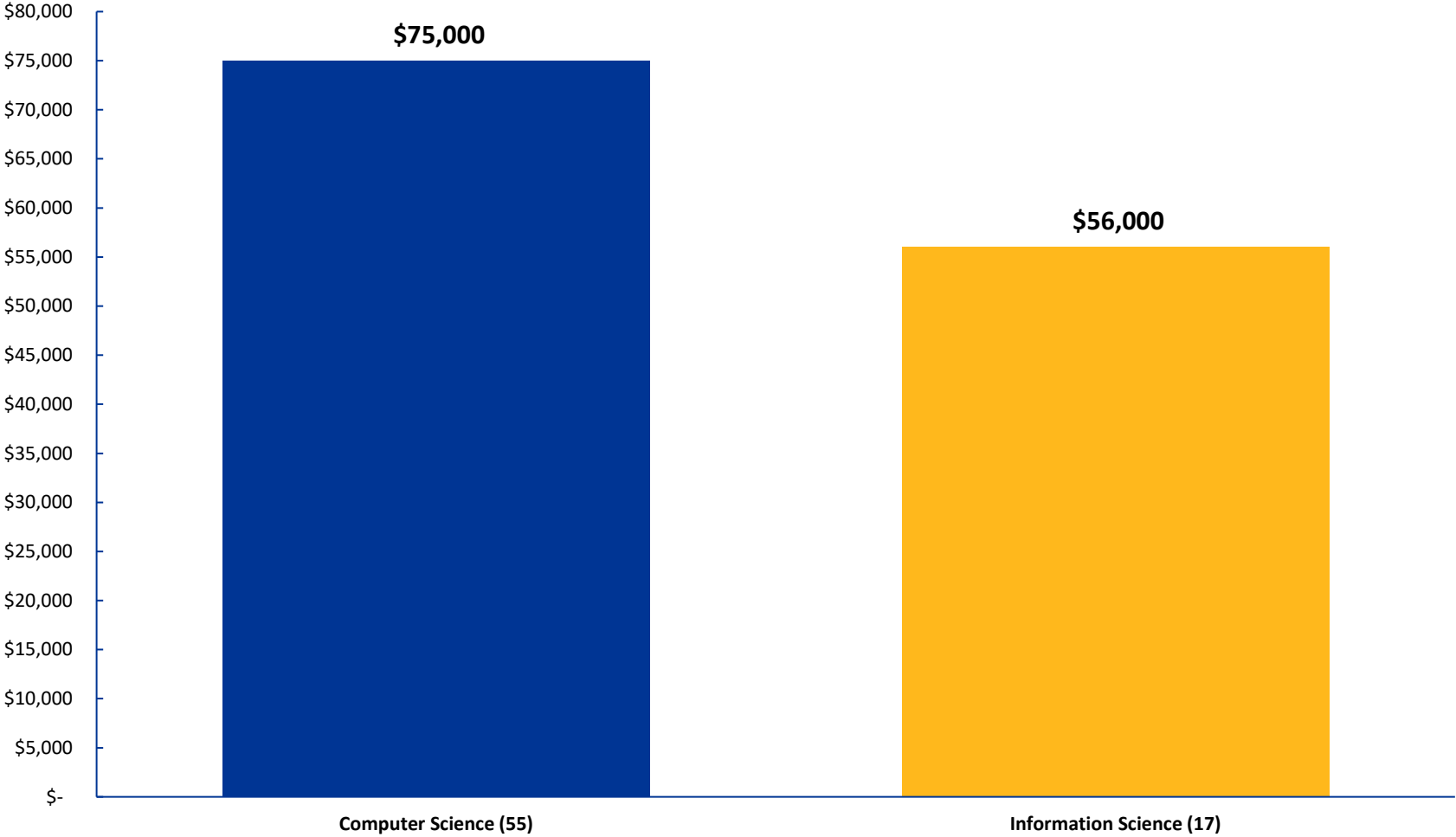

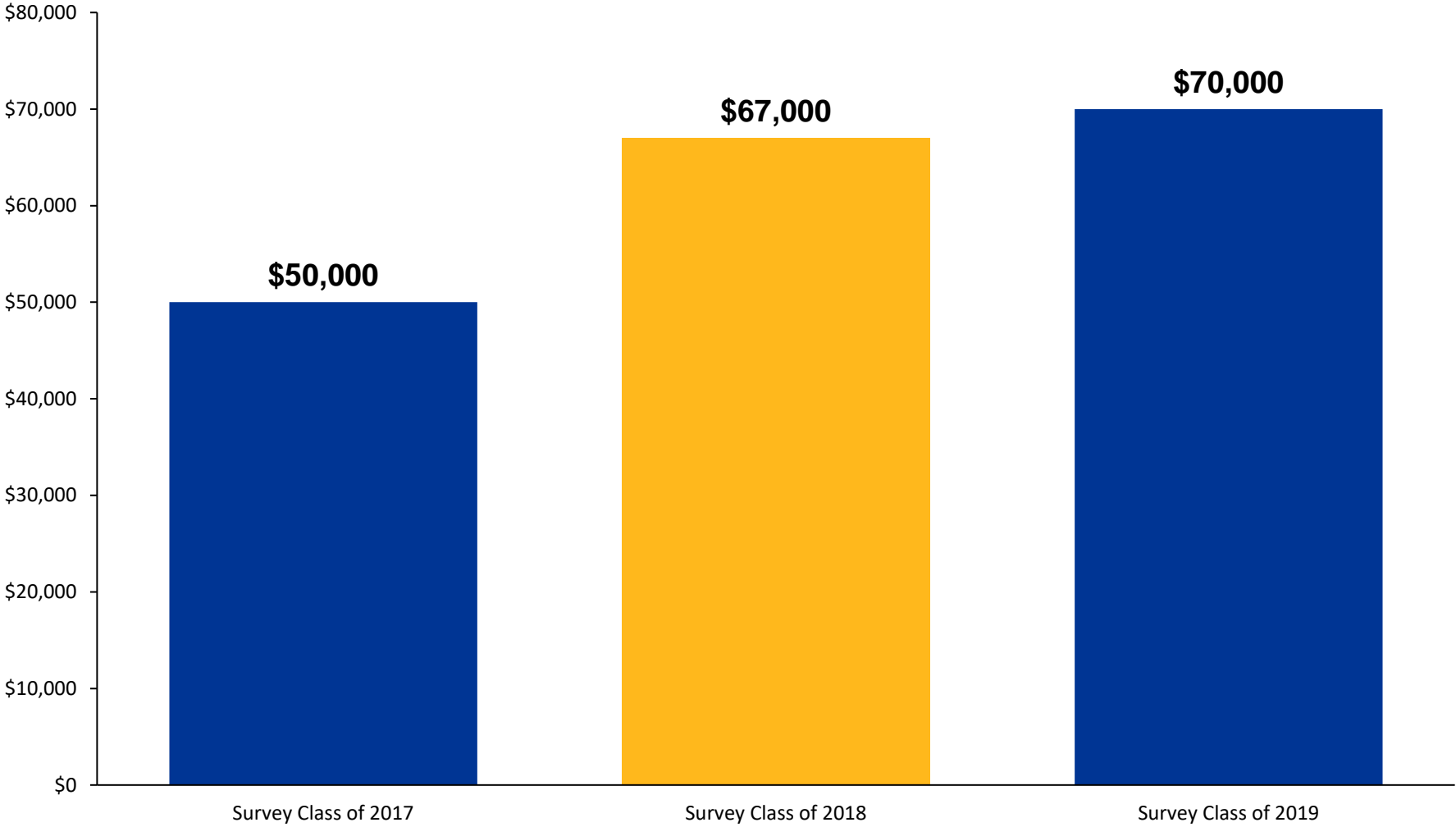

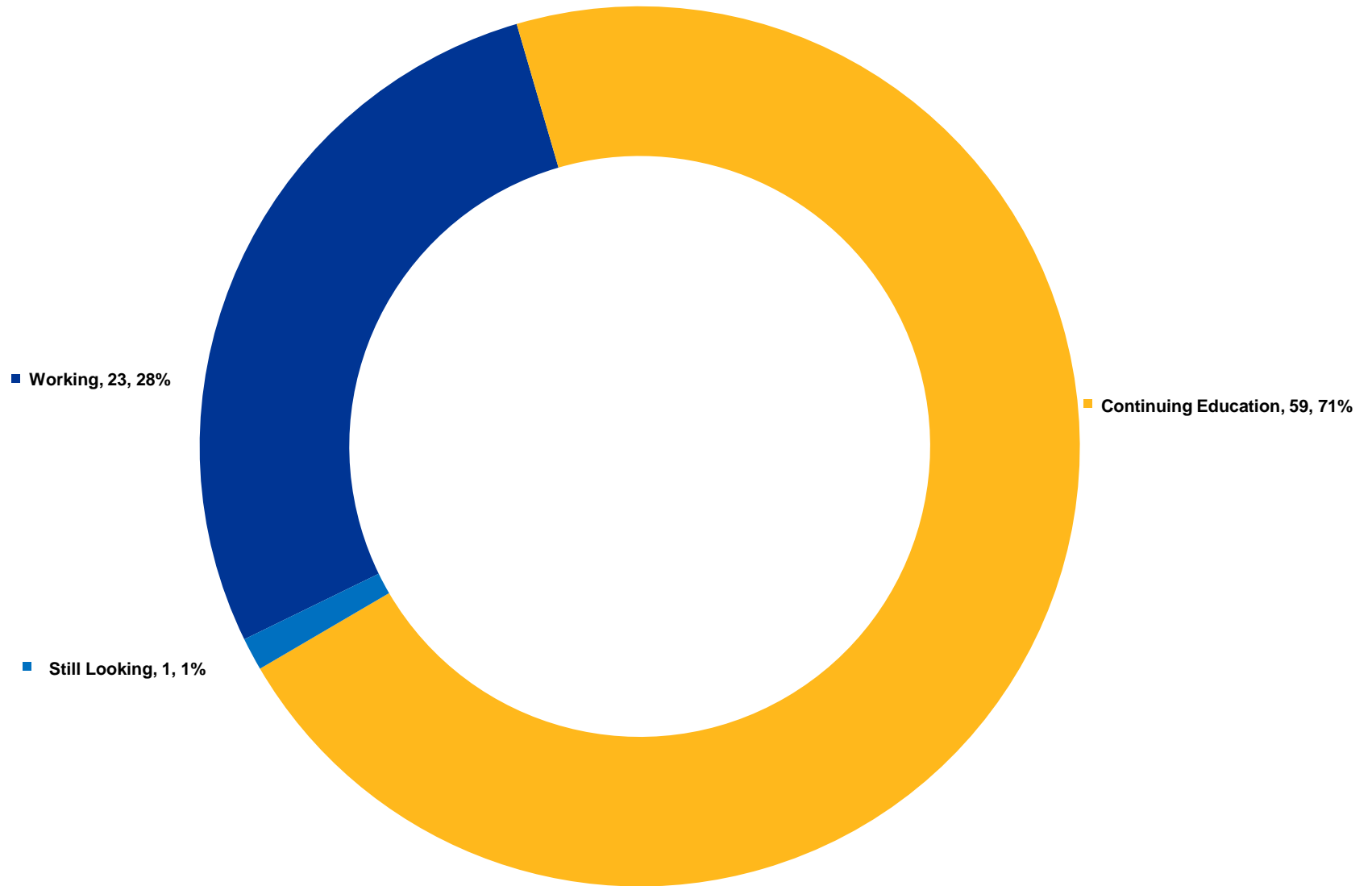

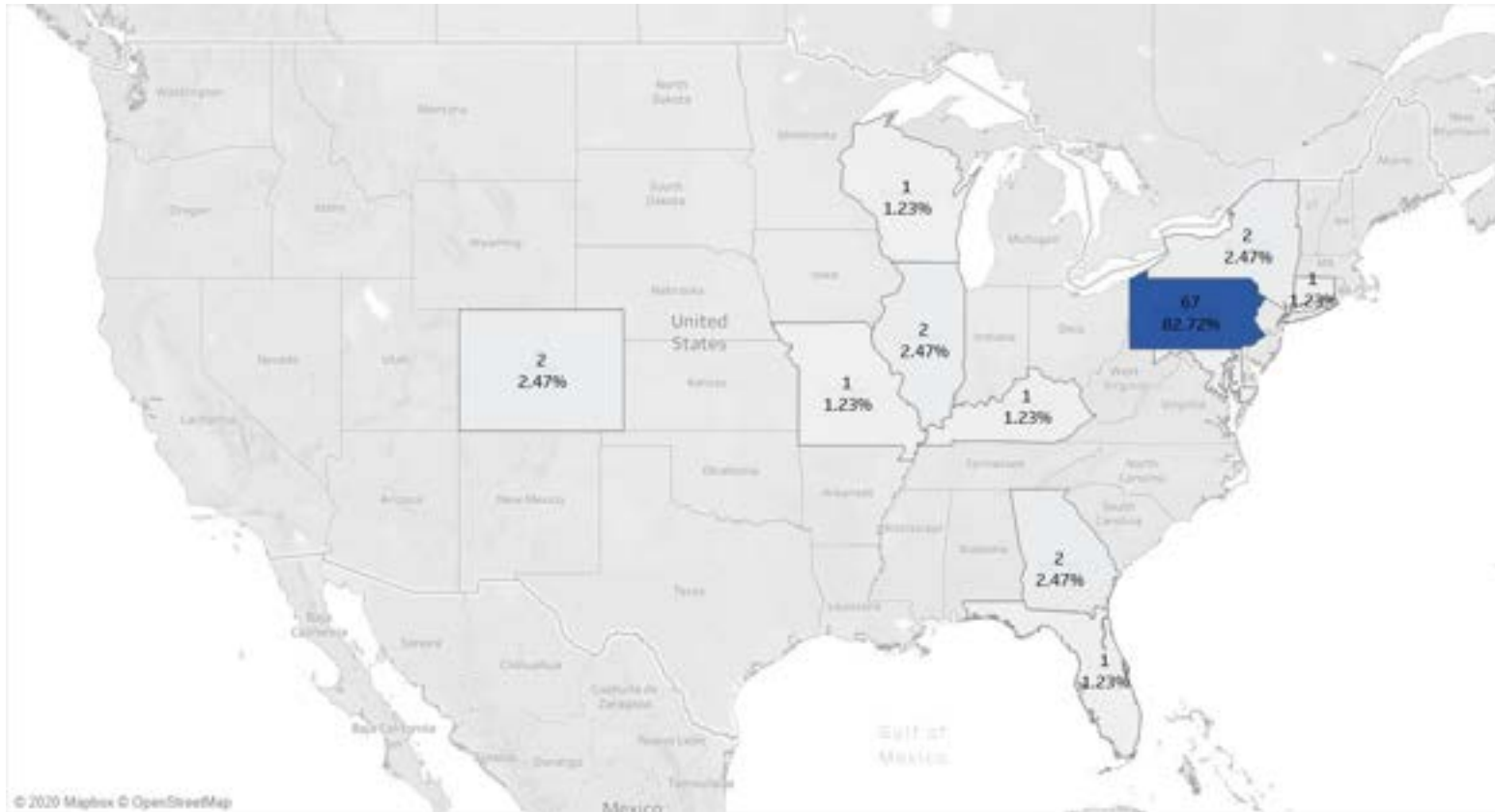

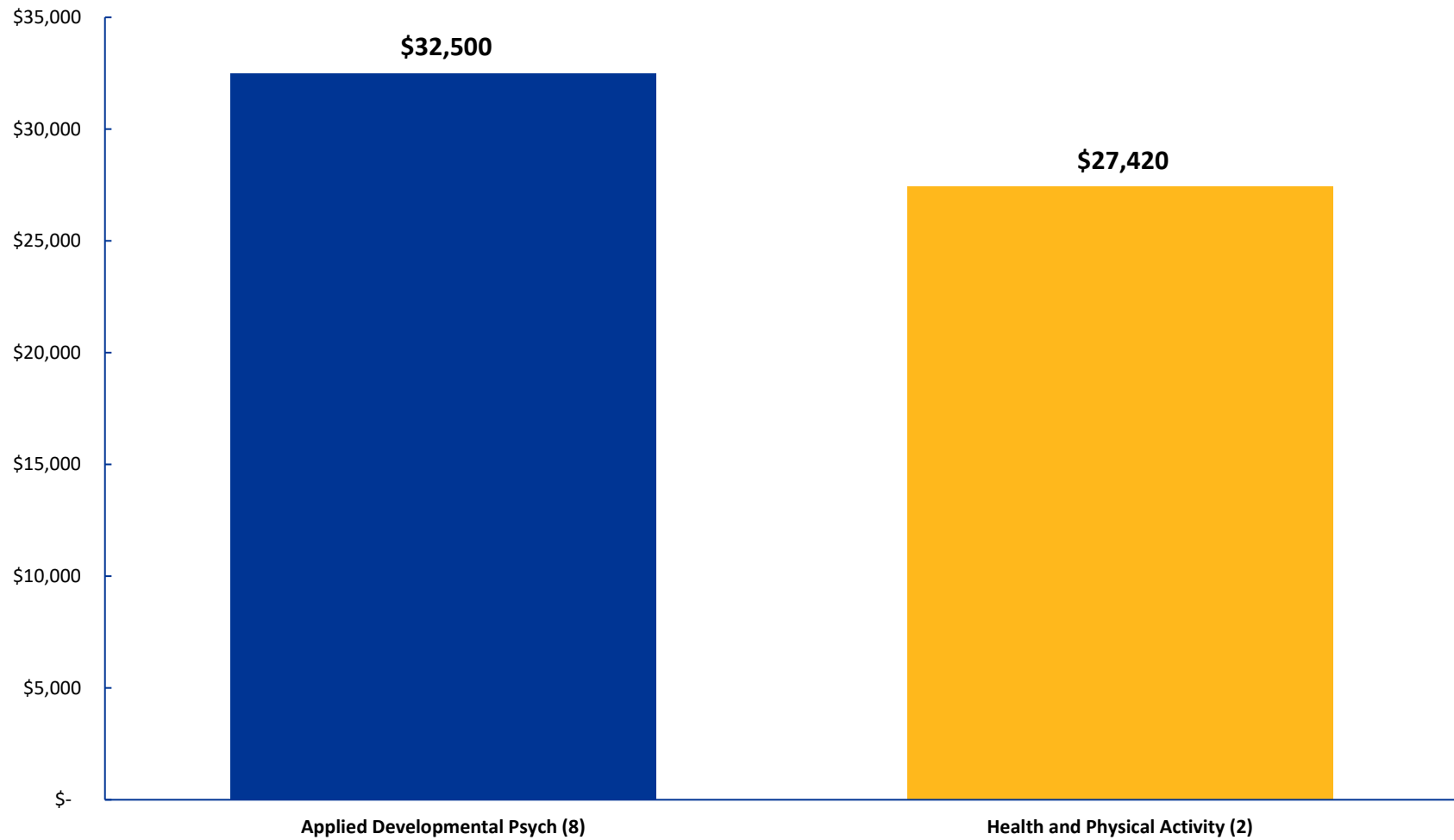

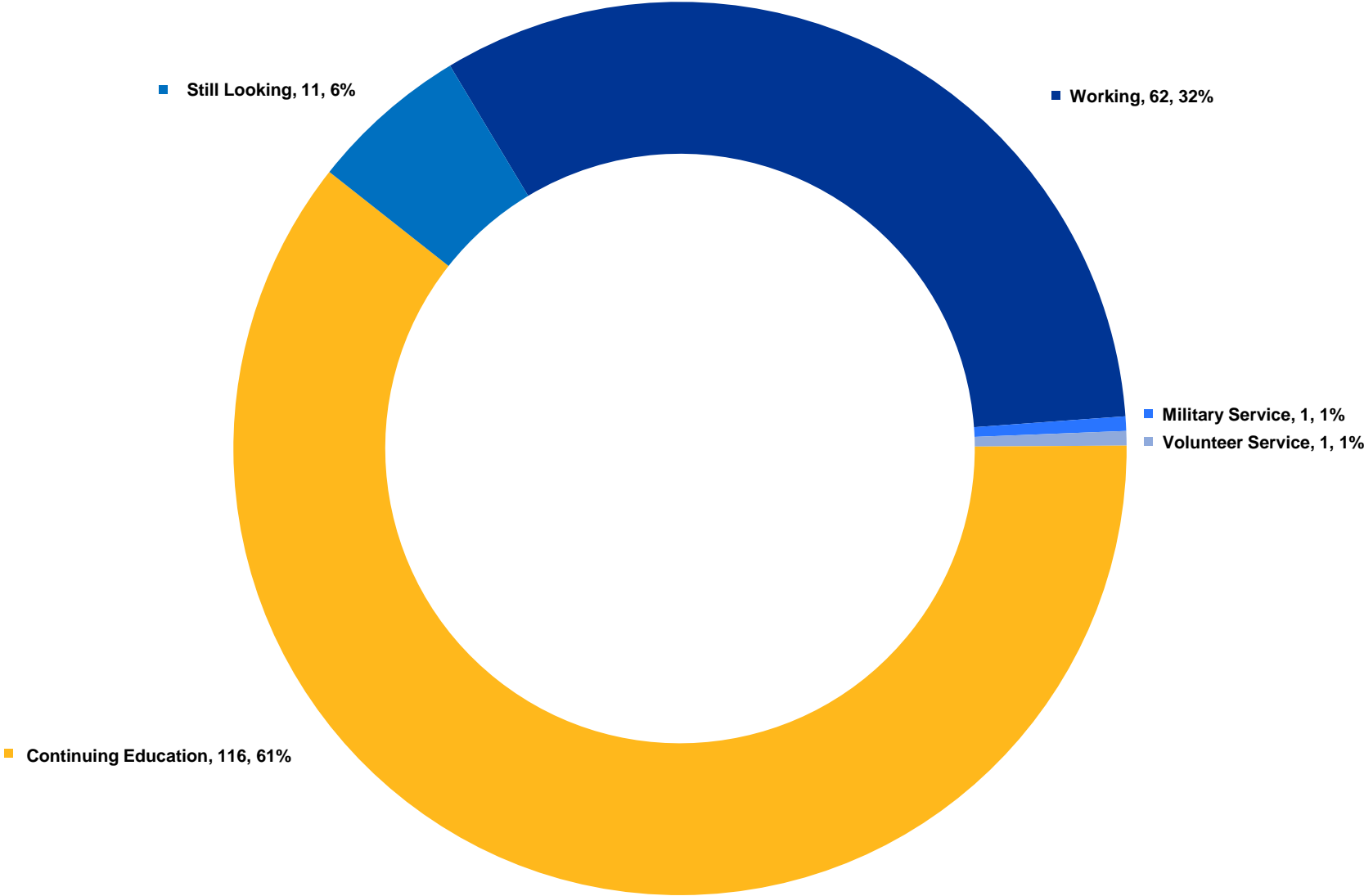

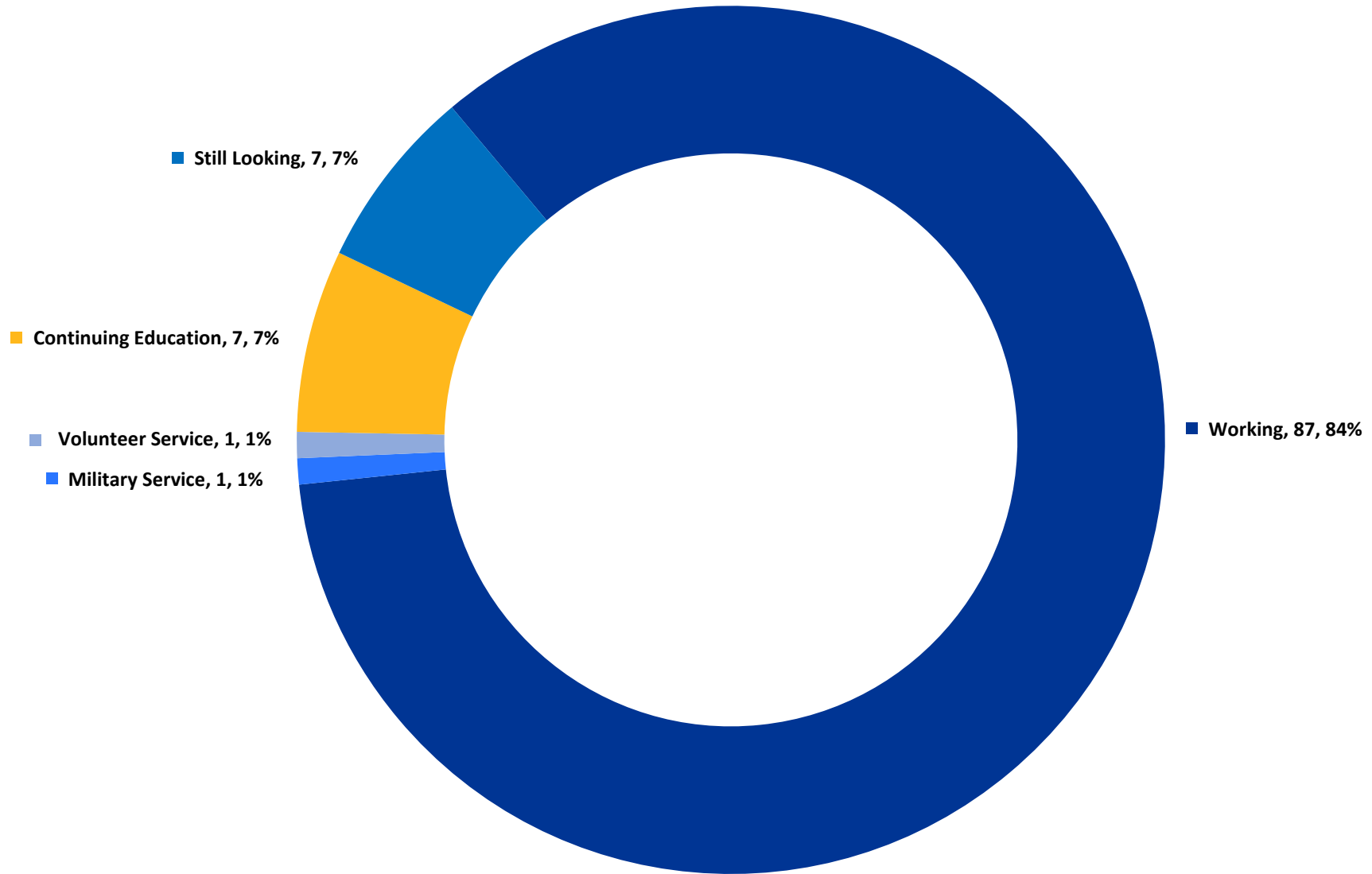

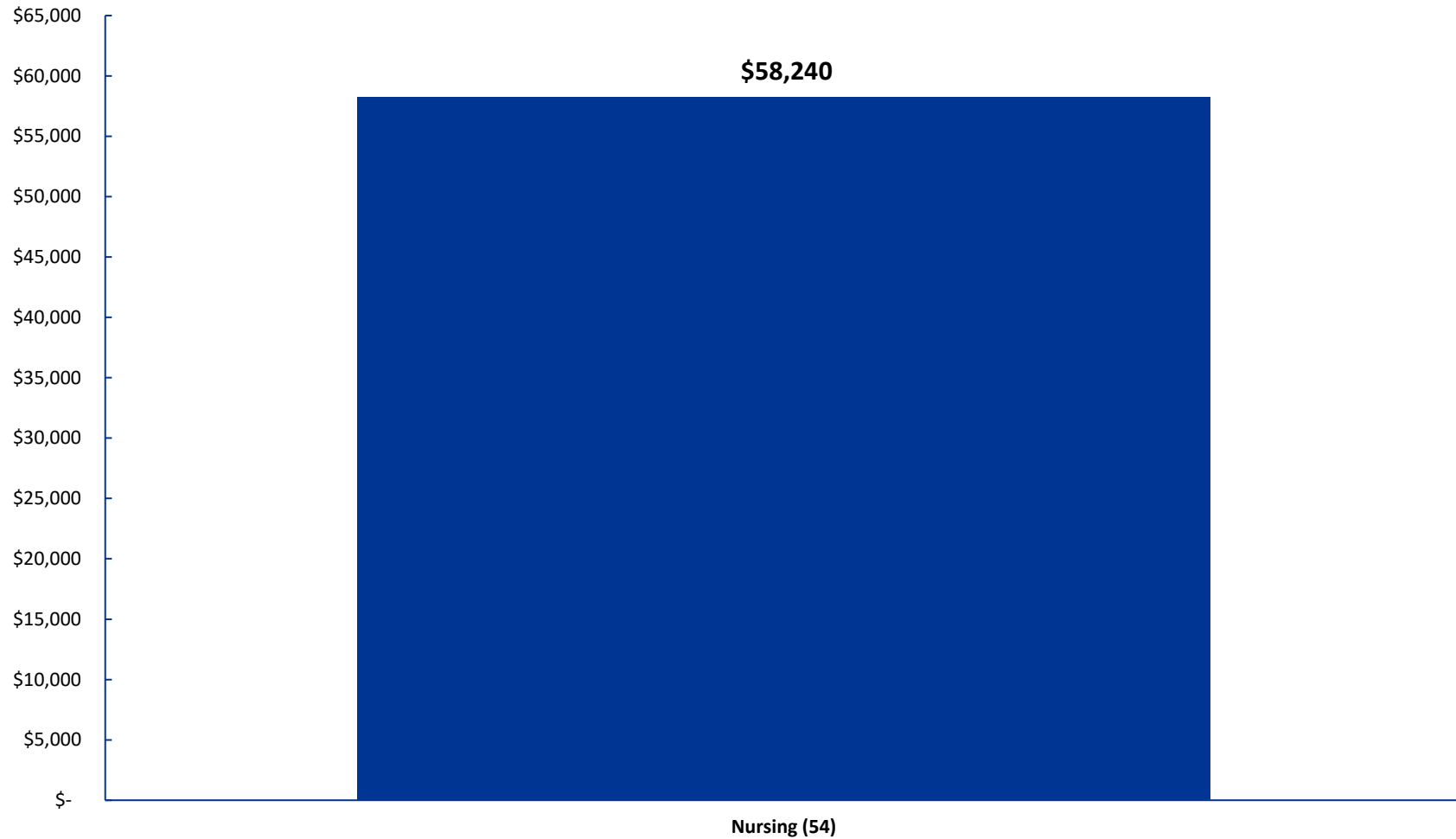

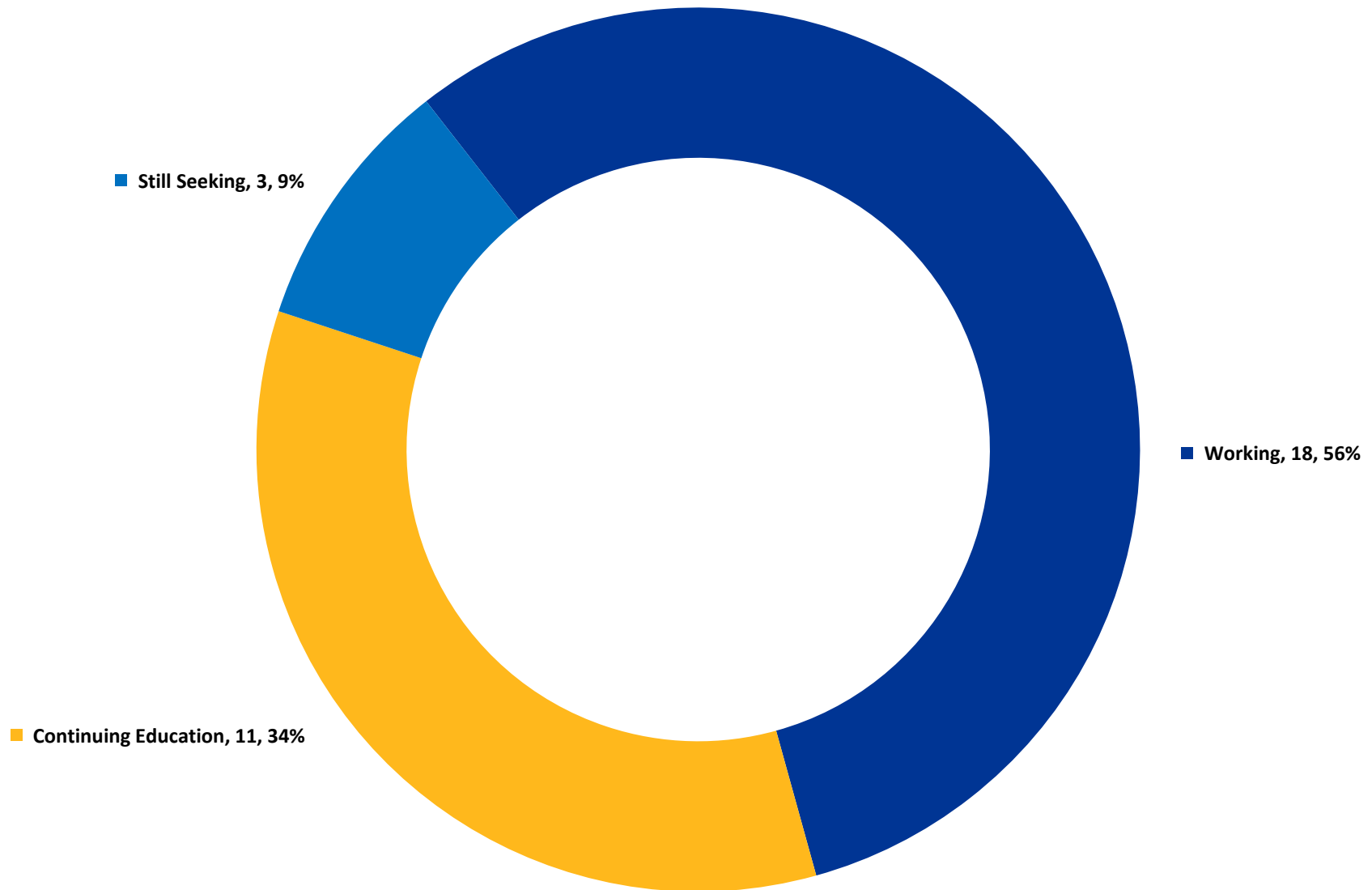

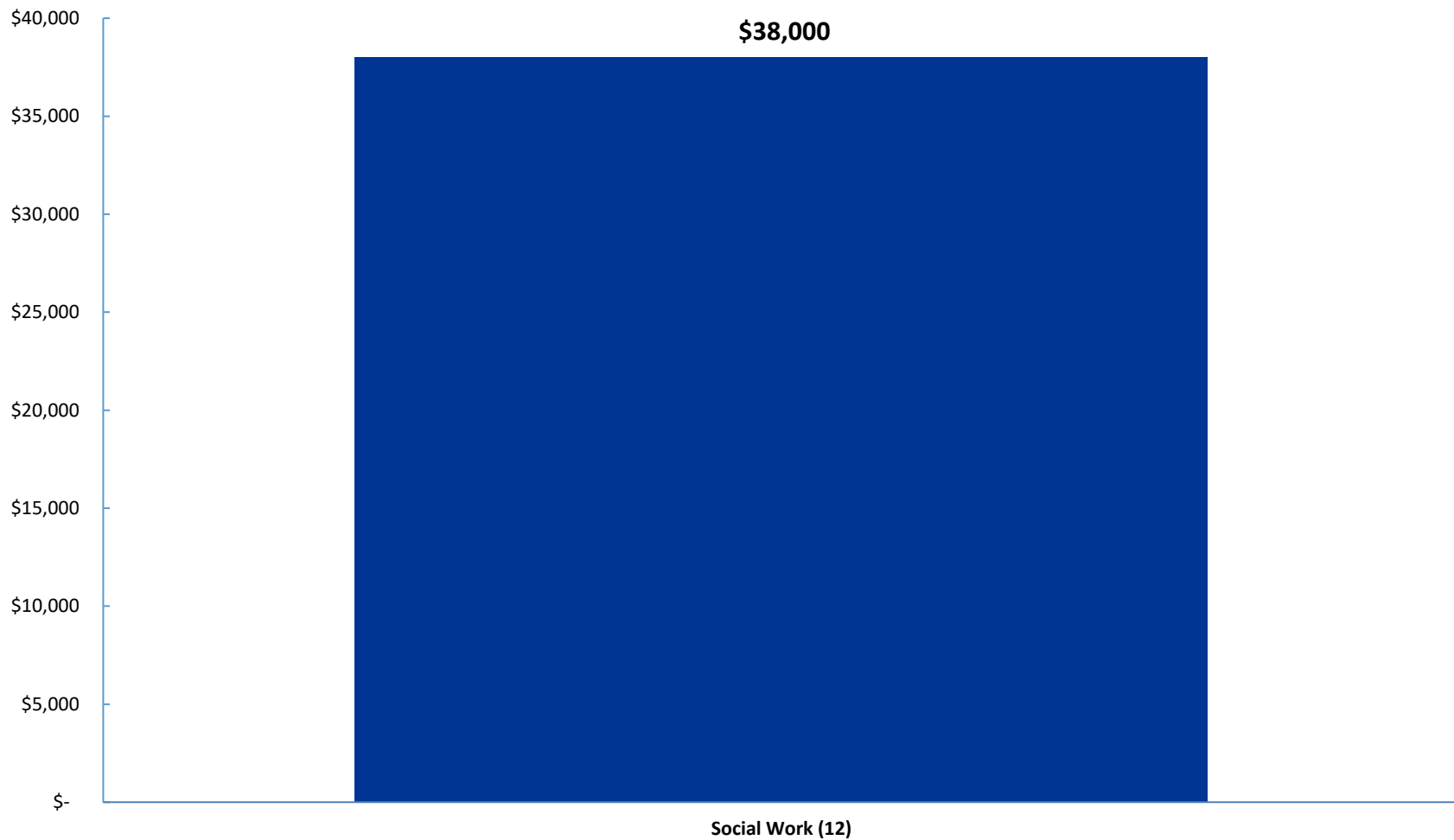

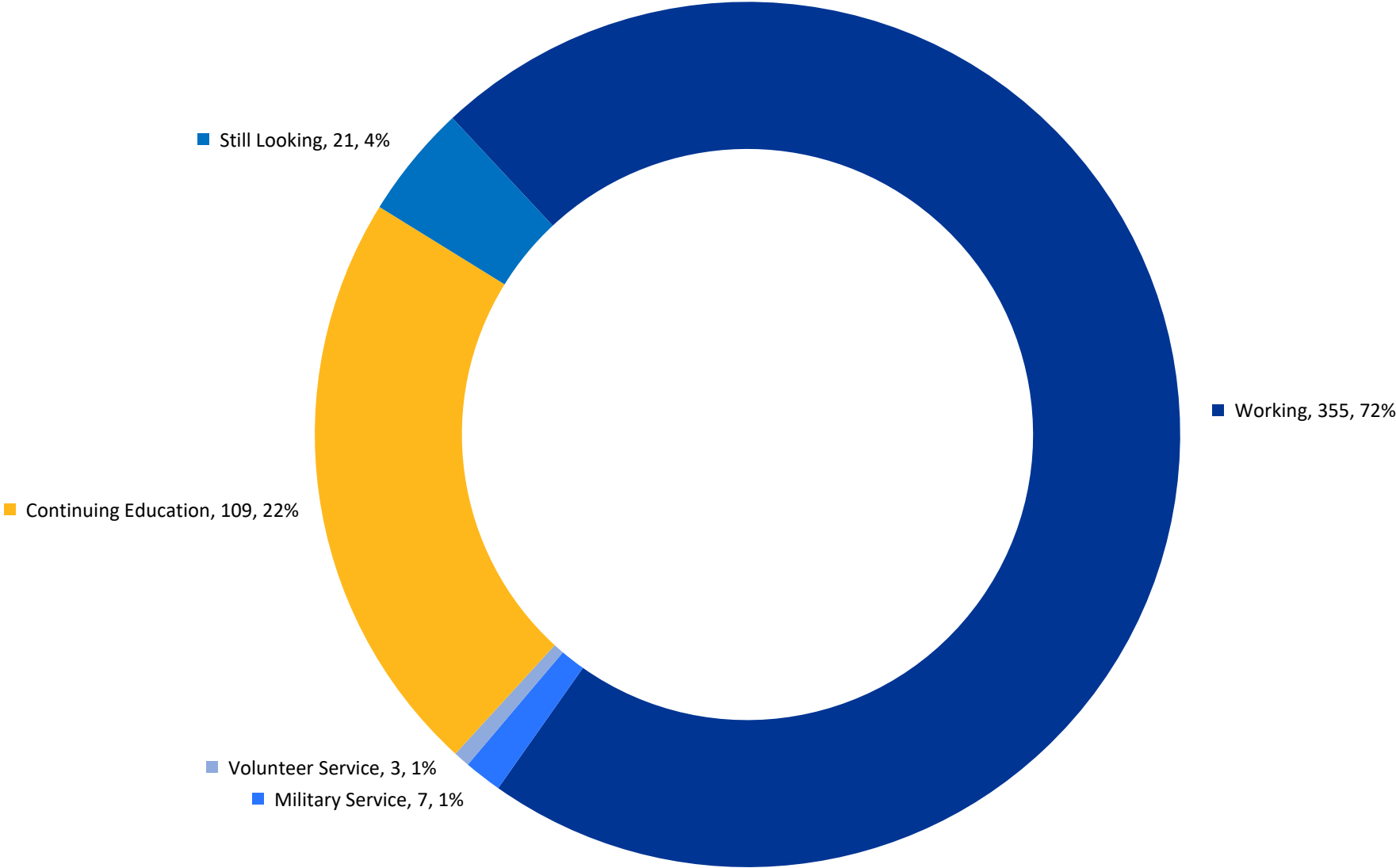

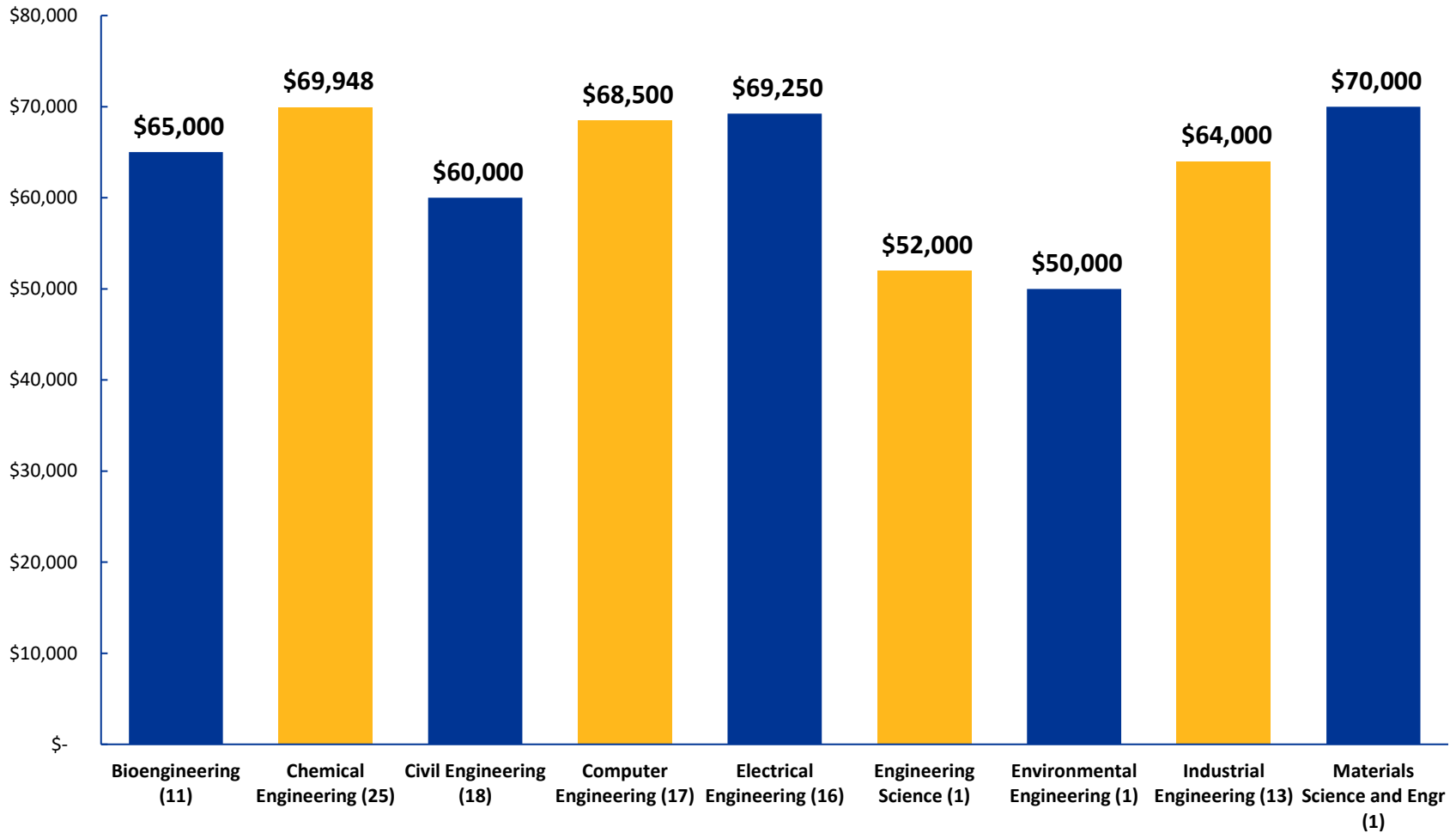

SUMMARY CALCULATIONS*

After the detailed data were transmitted to NACE, a number of summary calculations were developed from the data.

Knowledge Rate: This is the percentage of the graduating class for whom an outcomes destination is known. It includes the sum of all the employment categories, plus service and military, plus continuing education, plus the number of students still seeking an outcome or not seeking an outcome. It excludes those students for whom no information is available. Mathematically, the knowledge rate can be expressed as:

$(\# \text{ employed} + \# \text{ service} + \# \text{ military} + \# \text{ continuing education} + \# \text{ still seeking employment \& continuing education} + \# \text{ not seeking}) / \text{total graduates}$

Career Outcomes Rate: This is the number of graduates who have landed in any of the employment categories, plus service and military, plus continuing education divided by the number of students for whom an outcome is known. It excludes those graduates identified as not seeking an outcome.

Expressed mathematically the career outcomes rate is:

$(\# \text{ employed} + \# \text{ service} + \# \text{ military} + \# \text{ continuing education}) / (\# \text{ employed} + \# \text{ service} + \# \text{ military} + \# \text{ continuing education} + \# \text{ still seeking employment \& continuing education})$
