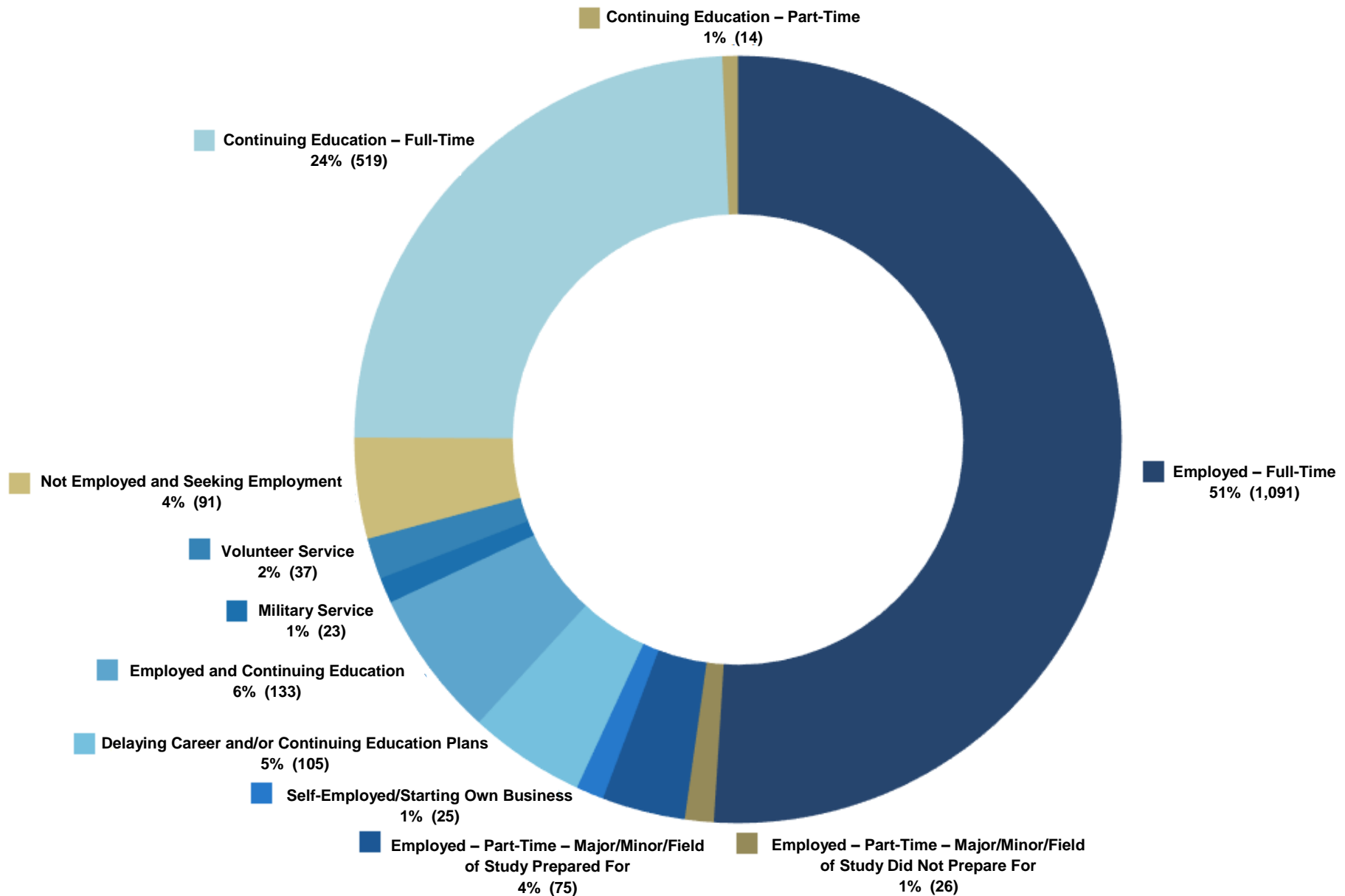

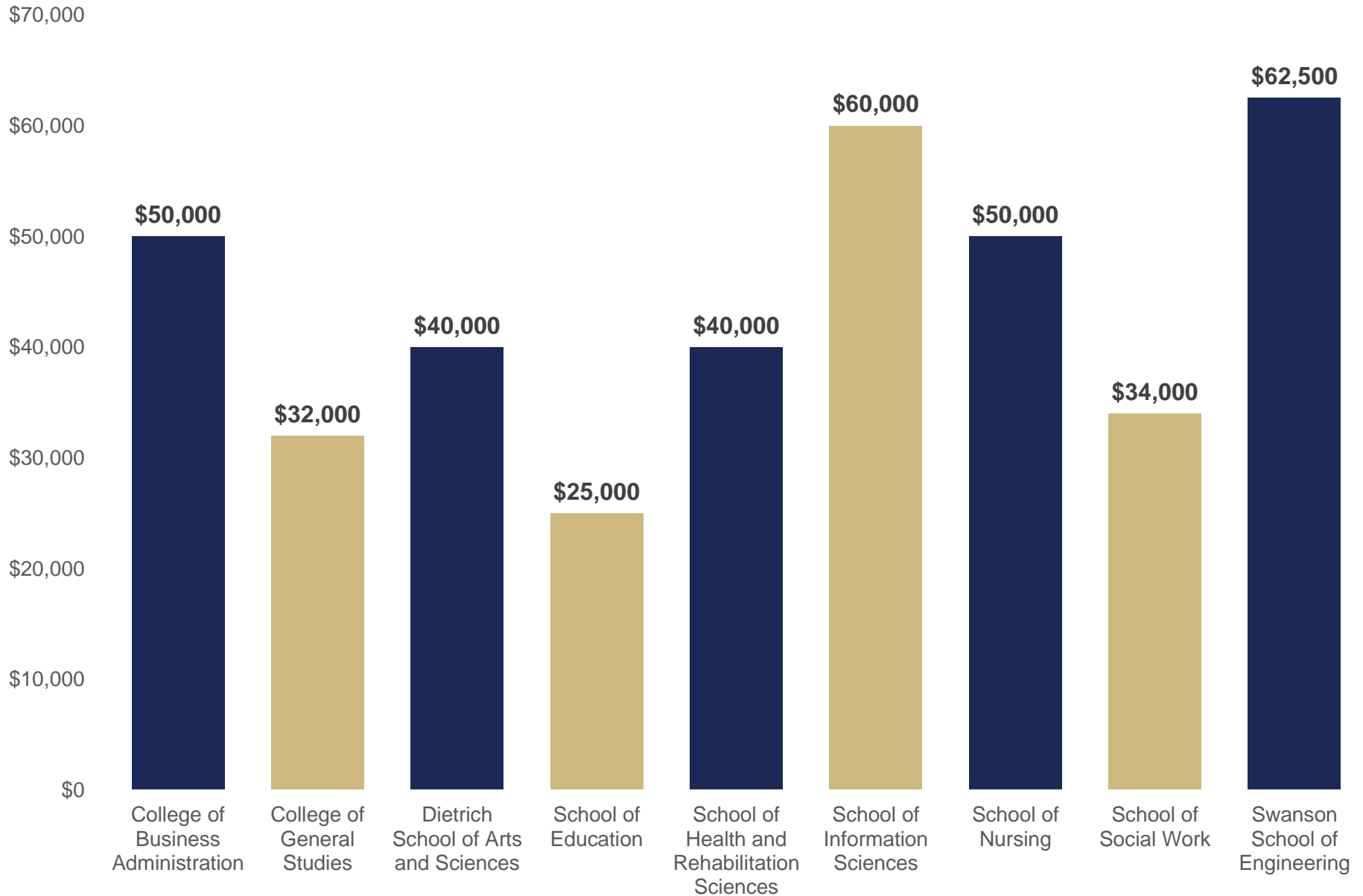

Of the 1,214 recent graduates who provided the name of their employer, **10%** (119 of 1,214) indicated that they are employed with UPMC, while **6%** (73 of 1,214) reported that they are employed at the University of Pittsburgh.
