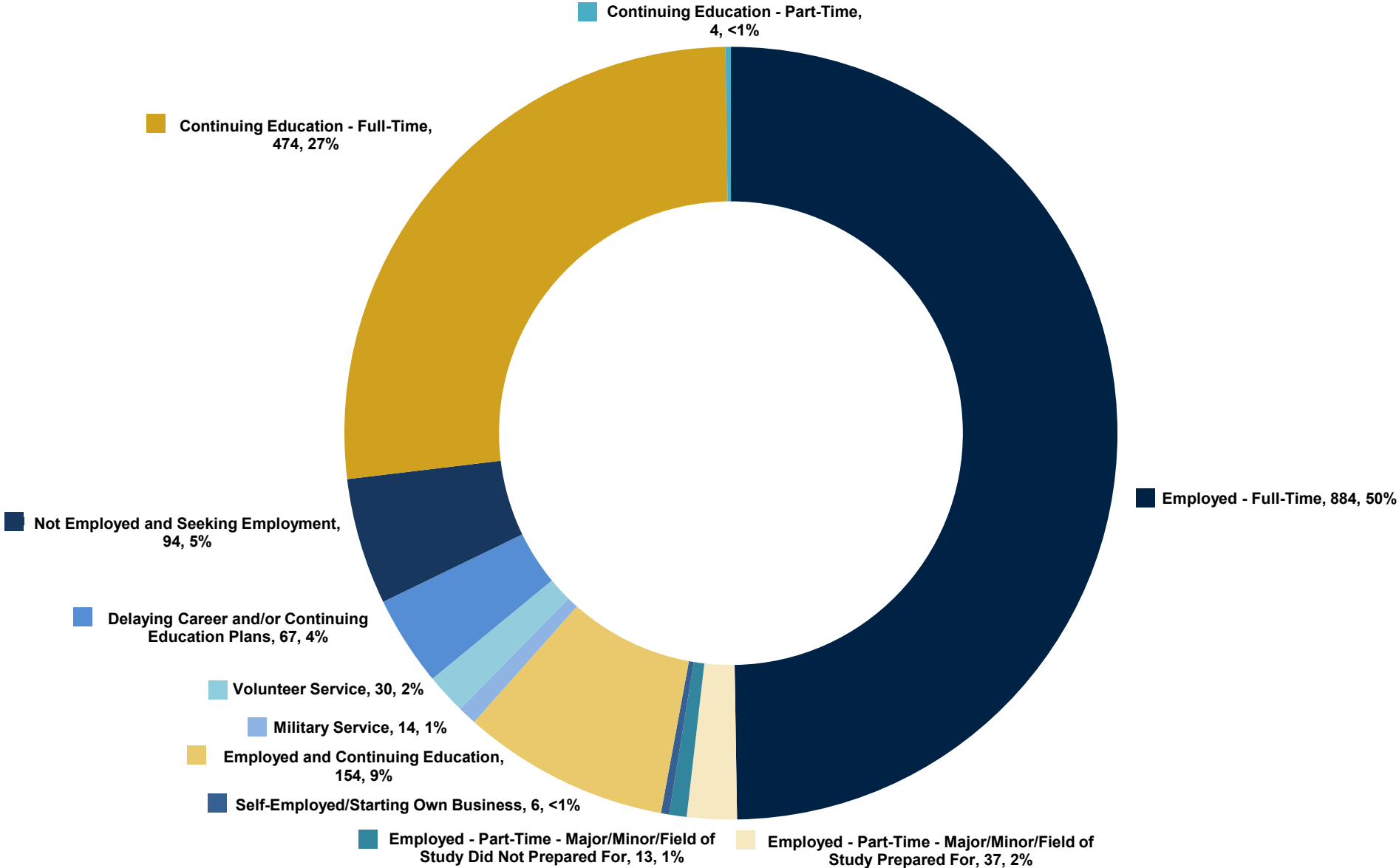

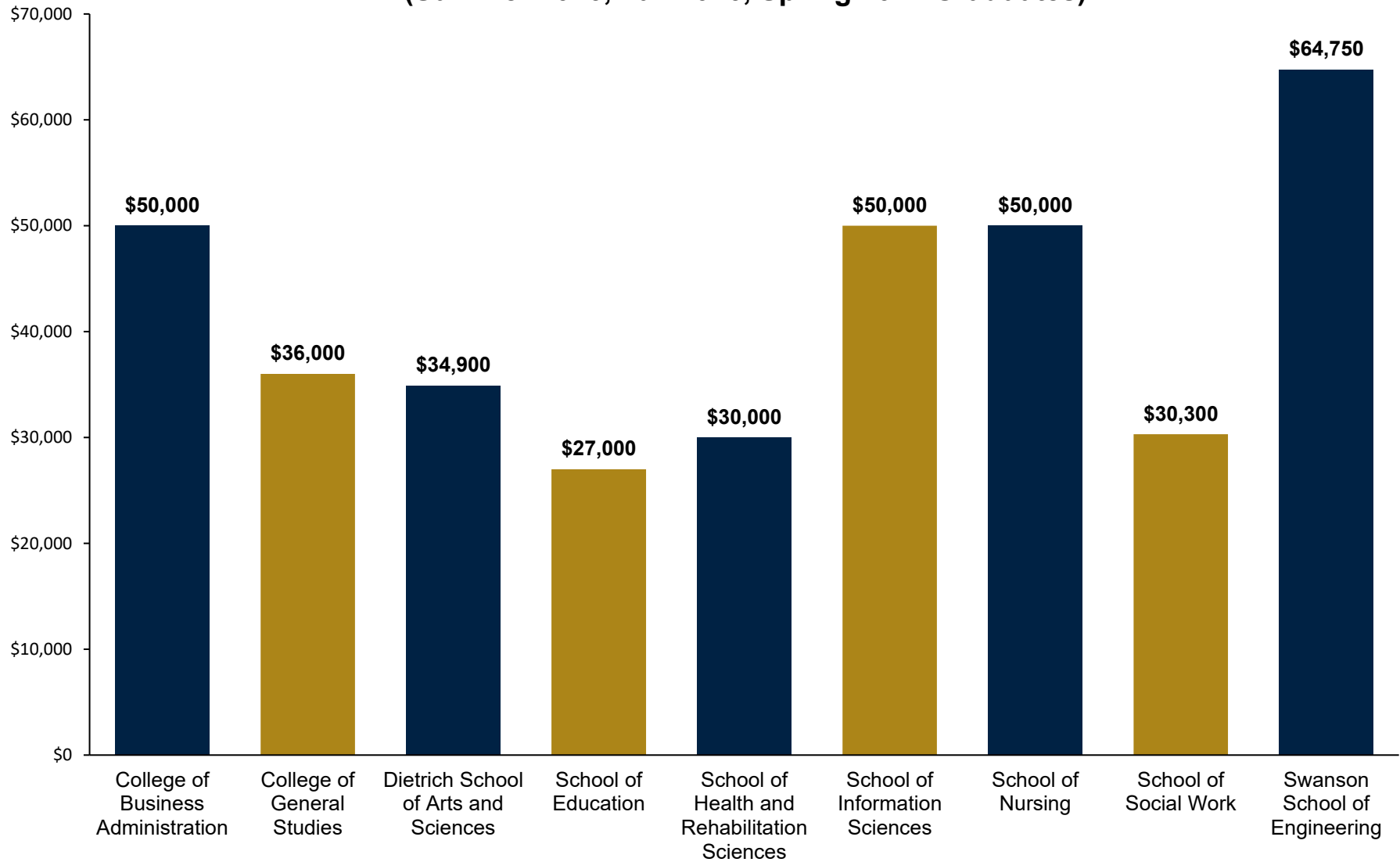

Of the 1,076 recent graduates who provided the name of their employer, **9%** (92 of 1,076) indicated that they are employed with UPMC, while **8%** (84 of 1,076) reported that they are employed at the University of Pittsburgh.

UPMC, the University of Pittsburgh, PNC Financial Services, BNY Mellon, PPG Industries, Pricewaterhouse Coopers LLP, and Deloitte Consulting have all been on the Most-Frequently Named Organizations Employing Graduates list consecutively for the last nine years (2009-2017).

Dick's Sporting Goods, and Eaton Corporation have made this list six out of the last seven years.
