## FRATERNITY AND SORORITY LIFE 101

Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 is a one-hour introductory program for students who are interested in joining a fraternity or sorority. All new members and aspirants must attend before accepting a bid to join a chapter. The program goes over the basics of our community, how to join, what to expect, and how to make it a positive experience.

- 1,244 students attended this year
- 94% of attendees found Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 helpful.
- 99.5% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel more comfortable identifying hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.
- 99.4% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel empowered to speak out against hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.

# Cathedral Standards of Excellence

## CATHEDRAL STANDARDS OF EXCELLENCE

The purpose of the Cathedral Standards of Excellence Program is to establish standards to ensure that every social fraternal organization at the University of Pittsburgh is fully committed to the highest quality of student experience for each of its members, with particular emphasis on academic achievement and campus involvement as defined by each organization.

The Office of Fraternity and Sorority Life believes the Cathedral Standards of Excellence Program will form a basic standard for all fraternal organizations and assist in supporting each organization's development. The Cathedral Standards of Excellence Program will provide a framework for self-assessment, individual and group accountability, greater achievement of organizational goals, and the development of programs and practices that will lead to substantial enrichment of the fraternity and sorority experience. This program recognizes and rewards those organizations that consistently exceed expectations as well as provides guidance and support to those organizations that fail to meet the expectations of the University and the Fraternity and Sorority Life Community.

This year, the Cathedral Standards of Excellence Program saw a rather large change. Instead of the traditional check box system of completion, we transitioned to a points system. In order to be eligible for the Cathedral Cup, chapters had to complete a certain number of points in each category, as well as receive 5 star chapter status.



Chapters received between 185 and 250 points.



Chapter received between 142 and 184 points.



Chapters received between 98 and 141 points. This was the expectation of chapters to complete at minimum 98 points.

Chapters received 97 or fewer points. Chapters at this level are considered to have not met our community standards. These chapters will participate in regular meetings with their Chapter Coach to work toward meeting minimum standards by end of the next year.
