


SCHOOL OF STUDY

MONEY RAISED FOR PDM

Pitt Dance Marathon is the largest student-run philanthropy at the University of Pittsburgh. Every school year, PDM staff and participants work tirelessly in an effort to enhance the movement that raises funds and awareness for UPMC Children's Hospital of Pittsburgh Foundation, part of the Children's Miracle Network Hospital system.

PDM is a yearlong fundraising effort supported by thousands of Pitt students, culminating in a dance marathon in the spring.

Since its inception in 2005, PDM has raised over \$2,000,000 for local Pittsburgh charities that benefit the Pittsburgh community. Now, in its tenth year official year as a student organization, PDM is aiming to break \$2.5 million!



FRATERNITY AND SORORITY LIFE 101

Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 is a one-hour introductory program for students who are interested in joining a fraternity or sorority. All new members and aspirants must attend before accepting a bid to join a chapter. The program goes over the basics of our community, how to join, what to expect, and how to make it a positive experience.

- 2,704 students attended this year
- 94% of attendees found Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 helpful.
- 99.5% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel more comfortable identifying hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.
- 99.4% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel empowered to speak out against hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.



Greek Week

Greek Week is an annual tradition that brings together members from all three governing councils at the University of Pittsburgh for a week of celebration, collaboration, and community engagement. It offers opportunities for chapters to build relationships, participate in friendly competition, give back to the community, express creativity, and—most importantly—have fun. While the primary events are concentrated into one week during the spring semester, Greek Week activities occur throughout the academic year.

Chapters are organized into teams that work together to earn points through various events, with top performers recognized at the end of the week. This year's Greek Week Board was an exceptionally dedicated and passionate group who successfully planned a dynamic and inclusive series of events, blending cherished traditions with exciting new initiatives.

Some highlights from this year's Greek Week:

- The return of community favorite **Archie Messersmith-Bunting** of Archie Cares, who delivered an impactful presentation.
- A powerful talk from **Matt Kovatchis** on mental health and resiliency.
- **Greek Sing** returned in person and partnered once again with Pitt Program Council for a vibrant outdoor event. Over 2,000 attendees braved the cool but sunny weather to cheer on creative performances from each team. A special addition this year: performances from our National Pan-Hellenic Council chapters, who showcased their signature step and stroll routines between team performances.
- Over **200 units of blood** donated during the Greek Week Blood Drives, supporting local healthcare efforts.
- A successful **donation drive, with 1,279 clothing items** collected for Thriftsburgh.
- The debut of **Greek Royalty**, a new program where community members nominated and voted for a Greek King and Queen. Over **1,400 votes** were cast in this exciting first year.

Greek Week 2024 was not only a celebration of community and tradition, but also a testament to the strength, creativity, and commitment of our fraternity and sorority members.

This program also recognizes and rewards chapters that consistently exceed expectations, while offering support and guidance to those working toward improvement.

PROGRAM UPDATES (2024-25 ACADEMIC YEAR):

This year, the Cathedral Standards of Excellence Program underwent a major overhaul. We moved away from the traditional checklist-style format and adopted a goal-oriented assessment model. To be eligible for the prestigious Cathedral Cup, chapters were required to complete a comprehensive end-of-year presentation and achieve at least a "Meets Expectations" rating in a minimum of four out of the eight evaluated categories.

Additionally, we replaced the previous star ranking system with a new honors-based recognition model:

- **Monongahela Honors:** Awarded to the top 15 chapters in the community
- **Allegheny Honors:** Awarded to the top 10 chapters in the community

These changes reflect our commitment to meaningful engagement, continuous development, and the pursuit of excellence within our fraternal community.
