Bringing in varies Guest Speakers to discuss topics within these issues, helped our students grow in more professional ways, and taught them how to show brotherhood to one another.

Additionally, our Tri Council community came together to put on a week-long of fun and educational programs for Greek Week, ending the week with fantastic performances during our Greek Sing event. Once again, this event was held outdoors during the Bigelow Bash weekend, which allowed our Fraternity and Sorority Life (FSL) community to flourish and shine in front of not only over 2,000 students, but also newly admitted students to the University.

ALINA'S LIGHT

The Greek Week Board brought in Alina's Light, an organization that educates and spreads awareness of Domestic Violence. Over 800 members of the community joined either in person or via Zoom to listen as Elly and Yan Sheykhet spread awareness of their daughters tragic and untimely death that occurred in October 2017 because of Domestic Violence.

FRATERNITY AND SORORITY LIFE 101

Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 is a one-hour introductory program for students who are interested in joining a fraternity or sorority. All new members and aspirants must attend before accepting a bid to join a chapter. The program goes over the basics of our community, how to join, what to expect, and how to make it a positive experience.

- 1,196 students attended this year
- 94% of attendees found Fraternity and Sorority Life 101 helpful.
- 99.5% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel more comfortable identifying hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.
- 99.4% of attendees either strongly agree or agree that a result of attending FSL 101, they feel empowered to speak out against hazing and other concerning behaviors within the Pitt community.
